TV Episodes

Day 1 (Wednesday, July 5, 2000) CBS Show

- On the first show, an hourlong affair, an instantly dislikeable chucklehead host named Ian O'Malley shows us around the house while a dopey correspondent from CBS's dreadful "The Early Show," Julie Chen, acts enthusiastic as the 10 residents travel to the house, O.J. style, in a caravan of SUVs.
- O'Malley shows us the house, including the confession room (where, each day, each resident is required to go in and share his or her feelings) and the bathroom (monitored to prevent the residents from sneaking into the toilet or shower to have private conversations). Meanwhile, Chen chats vapidly with the residents' friends and families, whom the show has gathered outside the house.
- At the end of the hour, the residents finally arrive. They meet one another and go into the house. The door shuts behind them. They roam from room to room. A solitary Jordan is caught at the end, gazing at the cameras and the two-way mirrors pensively, reality dawning. It's a lyrical scene.

Day 2 (Thursday, July 6, 2000) CBS Show

- The group sits around the kitchen table, sharing their life stories. The best part comes when Cassandra, who works at the U.N., says she's from New York. "Harlem?" asks cocky William, a little too quickly. "Midtown," she says calmly.
- Eddie tells the others he lost his leg to bone cancer at 11, but never let himself feel sorry for himself. "There was no real period of 'Why me?'" he shares. "It happened and I'll deal with it."
- Jordan tells the group she's a triathlete, but doesn't let on she knows her way around a gentlemen's club.
- When it's time for bed, William finds himself in the room with the women, and is dispatched tout de suite.
- There's a test for the residents, à la the reward challenges on "Survivor." They have to decipher a cryptographic message that tells them where some money is. (The money apparently lets them buy food from the producers.) They figure it out, but realize they have to wait until the morning to go digging in the backyard.
- The women have a late-night pillow party and talk about their dreams; zany Brittany has a dream interpretation book!
- Young Eddie tells the older Karen that there's going to be trouble between Mega and "the sister" -- Cassandra.
- At the end of the day, Karen ends up in the confession room, crying about having left her kids.

Day 3 (Friday, July 7, 2000) CBS Show

- George, the dad from Illinois, and Curtis, the lawyer, get up early and dig up the residents' \$100 prize in the garden.
- The challenge today is fashioning a clock using two raw potatoes as the battery. The chore would bore even an eager Cub Scout to tears; the audience could be forgiven for noting that the "Survivor" producers had their cast eating bulbous maggots at this point.
- The kids are going to get sick of having Mom and Dad around. Over breakfast, George gives an impassioned speech about his children: "That's my life, raising my family," he says. "You should know, it's not the sexual things, it's the companionship," he continues earnestly. Wonder if his wife feels the same way. He finally begins to cry. "I've never been away from them," he bawls.
- This sends Karen to the confession room again, crying as well. She has been in the house all of 24 hours and it's her second visit. George seems genuinely to miss his family; Karen, by contrast, is carrying a lot of negative emotional baggage. First chance she gets, she unloads on her husband in the confession room. "He brought up so much conflict, him being negative and not worrying about me," she sobs. We now know why Karen's in the "Big Brother" house. It was either that or Prozac.

- More girl talk: Karen hates beauty pageants; she doesn't know Jamie is a beauty queen. Later, Jordan confides to Jamie that she's a stripper. She calls it being an "exotic dancer." She decides she's going to wait a while before telling the others. Jamie indicates that she won't tell anyone.
- Cassandra catches Mega in the bathroom and talks straight: "They're gonna think you're a certain kind of brother when you go around shaking your booty," she says. She's telling him he's acting like a cartoon of a black guy. William's having none of it. "I gotta get something emotional goin'," he says. Speaking for many viewers, he says he's sick of the endless biographies being proffered.
- And then it's dress-up time! Brittany, sporting green lipstick, dresses up Karen in a wig and kewpie lips. Wacky George gets ahold of the wig, dons sunglasses and calls himself "No Soul"; with a few posture pointers from William, he does the funky chicken.

Day 4 (Saturday, July 8, 2000) CBS Show

Day 6 (Monday, July 10, 2000) CBS Show

- George and Eddy seemed to be having more fun than normal beating the dough to bake bread! William confessed his prank; Karen didn't believe him. The others were not too impressed. Eddy doesn't like Jordan because she criticized models and his girlfriend happens to be one. Brittany told him to confront her.

Day 7 (Tuesday, July 11, 2000) CBS Show

- A tense discussion took place regarding female sexuality, breast implants and stripping. Jordan suddenly goes quiet. William and Brit get into a big fight about racial issues. Will feels that he is the minority and that no one really can relate to him. Brit accuses him of using BB as a platform for his speeches and starts crying because she feels that Will is attacking her. Brit grew up in Northern Minnesota in a mainly black/spanish community and her best friend is black. Will and Jordan compare their back-ends, and Will says Jordan's butt is flat. Later he cops a feel which Jordan seemed to enjoy!! Jamie tells Curtis and Josh that she is the current Miss Washington. Curtis is very impressed! Eddy and Jordan have a heart to heart and Eddy tells Jordan he was upset about her comments on models. Jordan apologized and the two are friends again.

Day 8 (Wednesday, July 12, 2000) CBS Show

Day 9 (Thursday, July 13, 2000) CBS Live Nomination Show 1

- It's voting day in the house and all of the houseguests get all dolled up to go on TV live. CBS has interviews with Will's sister, Jamie's 3 friends, some health guy about emotional issues, some vegas odds guy and the AOL woman. They also interviewed Karen's husband who seemed like a pretty decent guy...
- Each houseguest took turns going into the Red Room to announce the 2 nominees they would like to be kicked out.
- Voting:
 - Jamie - voted Will and Jordan out after being told by BB she can't roll dice
 - Curtis - voted Will and Karen
 - Josh - voted Curtis and Brittany
 - Cassandra - voted Brittany and Eddy
 - Jordan - voted Eddy and Karen
 - Brittany - voted Will and Jordan
 - William - voted Brittany and Eddy
 - George - voted Will and Jordan
 - Karen - voted Will and Jordan
 - Eddy - voted Will and Jordan
 - Votes tallied as: Will (6); Jordan (5); Brittany (3); Eddy (3); Karen (2); Curtis (1); no votes against George, Jamie, Josh and Cassandra.

- Julie Chen told the house guests live that Will and Jordan are the two to be nominated for kick off. Will appeared happy; Jordan seemed sad. The public has one week to vote one off between the two. Call 1 (900) 740-1000 to vote in U.S. 1 (900) 870-9846 in Canada. Each call costs 99 cents U.S. After the announcement, Jordan wanted to know who voted for her and why. The house guests agreed not to reveal this info as it does no one any good. Over an hour later, Jordan is still whining about this issue on the live feed. Tonight's show was the best one yet! Good job CBS (finally)!

Day 10 (Friday, July 14, 2000) CBS Show

- Jordan whined all night about who voted her off. She told Will she doesn't want to be separated from him. Will and Jordan think the other house mates are all boring! Brit talks in the red room about how she feels like a backstabber and feels "icky". Dinner is very tense. They didn't speak to each other and Curtis didn't look up once! It was very hard to watch. Karen told Jordan she voted her off. She bawled like a baby and went on and on about how she doesn't want Jordan to be mad at her. Is Karen gonna cry every time she votes someone off?

Day 11 (Saturday, July 15, 2000) CBS Show

- The house guests had a bit too much to drink late Friday night, and Jordan spent most of her time crying her eyes out with Will on the top bunk in the girls bedroom. Eventually they all passed out, with Brittany, Josh and Karen all sleeping together in the "love bed". The three pushed beds together and all snuggled up...interesting! Last week, they were asked to wager a percentage of their grocery money on a challenge. They agreed to wager 20% and the Dead or Alive Challenge was held Saturday. Each were given 3 famous names and were asked to identify whether these people were dead or alive. Between the 10, they could only get 3 wrong. George and Curtis had 1 wrong each but overall, the group was doing very well. Then it was Will's turn and he got both wrong, resulting in the group losing the challenge (they lost \$70.00 of their \$350.00). Karen was especially mad! Eddie confronted Will and a big argument ensued. We wonder if it was on purpose... Josh and Brit slept together again Saturday night. We should keep our eyes on these two. Jordan told all in the house she's an exotic dancer - the secret is out!

Day 13 (Monday, July 17, 2000) CBS Show

- The house guests are given their second challenge; an exercise bike that they have to clock 1000 miles on by Friday night. The group agreed to wager 50% of their grocery money, and committed to clocking 200 miles per day between them. They all seem pretty burnt out already. The media has released the news that William is a member of the Black Panthers - a very controversial black rights group. The house guests don't know yet.

Day 14 (Tuesday, July 18, 2000) CBS Show

- The biking continues with Eddie using a crutch as his second leg and logging 100 miles towards the challenge. Karen watched each of the house mates take turns on the bike, yawning and smoking continually. The house mates are given another challenge; each are given a person in the house to impersonate. Will's impersonation of George in the Red Room was hilarious. Eddie's striptease (imitating Jordan) was even funnier! Jordan played Brittany very well! Josh, acting as Cassandra, tells Cassandra, acting as Jamie that he feels Josh is not representing himself correctly and needs guidance. Brittany and Jordan confront each other about their feelings about one another and each of their desires to have the most attention in the house. Brittany and Curtis snuggle up in bed together, and Curtis confides that the first time his Mom hugged him was when he graduated high school and his Dad when he turned 21. That's why he feels so dead inside.

Day 16 (Thursday, July 20, 2000) CBS Live Banishment Show 1

- The big day finally arrived, and the house guests got all dolled up again to go on live TV. Jordan and Will both had their bags packed and at the front door. Julie Chen interviewed Jordan's boyfriend, Ben, and sister, Elizabeth, and both said they believe Jordan is very stressed, and is having trouble communicating in the house. Julie also interviewed Will's girlfriend, Naiema, Dad, Bill and sister, Lynn. Julie announced the results of the week long poll as: 73% votes to Will and 23% votes to Jordan. Will instantly got up after saying his usual "yeahhhh", walked to the front door, picked up his bags and walked out without saying a word to his roomies for the past 2 weeks. They all followed him out the door and asked if they could say goodbye. Will reluctantly went back and hugged all of them, except Brittany and Eddie. Will was very happy to see his girlfriend, who didn't seem upset at all about Will's flirting while in the house, or his outrageous behaviour.
- Julie interviewed Will and asked him that while in the house, was it possible to forget about the cameras constantly watching. He said they made too much noise to forget about them, however, he did forget about the microphones. He said he wouldn't change a thing in the house and that he played the prank on Day 6 because he was bored. He also said he sabotaged the challenge last weekend because he wanted them to struggle and life was too easy. He felt that there was no competition. Will was played some video of his 16 days in the house, and was shown the clips of the Red Room when his roomies nominated him out. He was also asked about the articles on his connection with the Black Panthers and said he has not been a member for 4 months. Will will appear on the morning show tomorrow with Bryant Gumble.

Day 17 (Friday, July 21, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 16-17 are shown. Brittany asks Jamie if she likes Eddie. Jamie says she is not interested in him in that "way" because Eddie has a serious relationship with a girl that lives in Germany. Brittany then tells Eddie about their conversation. Eddie talks about Jamie in the Red Room.
- Jordan was shocked that she was the one to stay in the house. She was all ready to go. The girls get together to talk about Will, while the boys do the same in the yard. All of them later get together and talk about their worst memories of Will and their best.
- Jordan goes to the Red Room and says that she's about to go to war with Brittany over Josh. Jordan believes that she has a special connection with Josh and believes she can play with Brit's head.
- All the house guests are in the living room drinking, with Josh stroking Brittany's hair. Jordan takes Josh to the washroom where some serious flirting occurred. Later, Josh and Jordan end up in bed together in the dark, both admitting they are physically attracted to each other. Jordan said that they are having the "want to have sex" talk. After both admitted they are sexually frustrated, it appears 100% obvious that something is going to happen between the two.

Day 18 (Saturday, July 22, 2000) CBS Show

- A recap of the week was shown, with a focus on Day 17. Jordan tells Josh, Curtis and Eddie that she is sexually frustrated, while floating in the pool in her bikini. Eddie calls her a nympho. Jordan then asks them if they would masturbate in the house. Eddie said he wouldn't, but Curtis admitted he would. Later, Brittany and Josh begin flirting, with Brit riding Josh in the pool. Cassandra and George put on a show pretending to be the hosts of a cooking show and interviewing the house guests (quite amusing). That evening, Eddie gives Jamie a massage in the yard, going up the back of her shirt (she was wearing a bikini). Jamie seemed quite shocked by the move and became quite flustered. The group participated in a discussion about true love, unconditional love and love at first sight, with Jordan going on in her usual analytical fashion. They then discuss the atmosphere in the house without Will, all agreeing that they are more relaxed without Will around and life seems easier. Eddie enters the Red Room and confesses that he can't stand Jordan's continuous backstabbing, and can clearly see the difficulties between Jordan and Brittany. At the end of the night, Jordan and Josh are alone in the bathroom and Jordan kisses Josh on the cheek with a toothpaste mouth. They talk about their attraction to each other and how the others don't have a clue.

The group sets up their beds in the living room under a big blanket, however, all opt to sleep in their bedrooms for some reason unknown to me. Jamie, Josh and Brittany participate in the love bed, and poor, lonely Jordan ends up alone! I guess there's no more girls and boys rooms. Wednesday is the live edition of the next banishment nominations!

Day 20 (Monday, July 24, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 19 and 20 are shown. Josh and Brittany continue to flirt in the bedroom. Brittany tells Karen and George that she is really turned on by Josh and feels that she must keep her distance. She decides that snuggling in the love bed is definitely out! Later, Eddie teases Josh about the love bed and all the women jumping over him to get into their favoured sleeping positions. Jordan tells BB in the Red Room that nothing will happen between Josh and Brit as long as she's around. The next scene, Jordan is inviting Curtis to sleep in her bed! Eddie confides in Brit about his planned voting strategy. He told her he plans to nominate Jamie and Jordan off on Wednesday. He expects Jordan to be voted out, then he will next nominate Jamie and Josh. Next he will vote whoever is left of the two and Curtis; then whoever is left and Cassandra. He believes the last four left will be Karen, George, Brit and himself. He then suggested Brit and him form an alliance, and each vote out Karen and George....hmmmmmm, then what?
- Day 20 - The house guests are given their next challenge - to set up 12,100 dominos arranged according to diagrams provided. They have until Friday noon, and then when BB says, they must set the dominos off by pushing one domino. The group agrees to wager only 20% of their grocery money this time. The group participates in a mock trial which was pretty amusing. Karen later confesses to George that she plans to nominate Jamie and Curtis out of the house, followed by Cassandra. She said she believes Eddie and Jordan will each receive many nominations because Jordan is just Jordan, and Eddie is too harsh. The show ends with Brit and Karen doing some kind of strange dance walk down the hallway.

Day 21 (Tuesday, July 25, 2000) CBS Show

- It's 3:00 a.m. and Josh and Brittany are lying on the couch talking while Jordan is sitting out by the pool alone. Brit suggests that Josh go out to see if she's okay. Josh and Jordan then get into quite a long discussion about relationships, and Josh tells Jordan he doesn't think they are compatible, and he's new to the dating scene. Jordan tells Josh she thinks he is naive to Brittany, and that she doesn't want to be part of a love triangle. Josh looked awfully uncomfortable! That morning, Cassandra and George are speaking and George tells Cass he is worried about Eddie, and believes that Eddie doesn't feel well a lot of the time, but would never tell the group. George believes that the chemotherapy Eddie underwent has made him sick, and that he feels Eddie needs to be looked out for. Cassandra and Karen have a private conversation in the backyard, with Karen telling Cass what's going on between Brit, Jordan and Josh. Both agree that Jordan needs to go. Jordan and Curtis talk privately in the living room and Jordan says she feels like she doesn't fit in and she needs something more than just this "fluffy stuff". She had huge bags under her eyes and looked pretty bad. Curtis tells her that she needs to relax and enjoy herself, and to look at this as a learning experience. Later, the group teases Josh about how they believe he will become a teen idol and will be featured in Teen Magazine or Seventeen. While this was going on, Eddie was outside in the yard by himself, playing with rocks and looking quite sad. While lying in their beds, George tells Eddie he worries about him and offers to make him special recipes to eat. Eddie thanked George and assured him he's okay and doing much better now that Mega is gone. George then confides in Eddie that Curtis intimidates him, and he believes Curtis looks down on him because he is not educated. Eddie is quite surprised by this, and tells George he will kick Curtis' ass. He then suggests that George nominate Curtis out tomorrow and that his own vote has just changed because of the conversation. Can't wait to see who's nominated tomorrow!

Day 22 (Wednesday, July 26, 2000) CBS Live Nomination Show 2

- Julie Chen opens the show, with Eddie teasing Karen about drinking all the supply. Eddie is in the Red Room suggesting that sooner or later, the atmosphere will become cut throat. The three way thing is still going on between Jordan, Josh and Brit. Jordan feels Josh's but in the bathroom, and Brit confides her feelings to Jamie. The guys get a makeover, including make-up, pigtails and glitter. George looked hilarious! George chases Josh around the yard and Jordan actually looked jealous (hehehehe). Julie goes live to the house guests waiting patiently in the living room. Brit is dressed in a nice dress with a long wig. Jordan is dressed like a guy; a strong resemblance to Will (Mega). The nominations are then announced and they go like this:
 - Eddie - Jordan and Curtis
 - Jordan - Eddie and Karen
 - Josh - Curtis and George
 - George - Curtis and Jordan
 - Karen - Curtis and Jordan
 - Jamie - Curtis and Eddie (rolled the dice again)
 - Curtis - Eddie and Karen
 - Cass - Eddie and Jordan
 - Brit - Curtis and Jordan
 - Total: Curtis (6), Jordan (5), Eddie (4), Karen (2), George (1), Jamie, Brit, Josh, Cass (0)
- When the nominations were announced, Curtis looked shocked, and Jordan carried on in the same fashion as last time. The others looked very uncomfortable. Curtis asked that they not act wierd around him all week. Jordan left to have a shower. Brit looked awfully happy!!! Other parts of the show tonight included a clip of Will's life since banishment, including talk shows, autographs and his homecoming; a surprise party for George's wife and kids in Rockford, Illinois; an interview with Dr. Drew Pinsky, a Health and Relationship Specialist; a chat with Josh's friend, Jeff, who believes Josh is playing his own game; and an interview with the AOL Internet Specialist. I swear I saw Will in a Subway commercial about 38 minutes into the show... Should be an interesting week....

Day 23 (Thursday, July 27, 2000) CBS Show

- Before the Nominations: Brittany and Jordan whisper in the living room about Josh, while he sleeps on the next couch. They compare stories about how Josh has acted with both of them, and Brit ends up crying, saying she's tired of being everyones buddy and will never find a soul mate. She said that it's pathetic that she's still a virgin at 25. Jordan told Brit she believes Josh is keeping his options open, and playing them both. They then discussed playing a game with him whereby they each come on to him taking turns.
- Brit later confides in Karen and tells her the story about Jordan and Josh. She also told her about their plan to come on to Josh and mess with his mind. Karen asks Brit how she knows that Jordan is being honest. Brit responds that Jordan said words verbatim that Josh said to her.
- Later, Karen gossips to Cass and Curtis about the 3 way thing going on with the others, and ends up bawling because she said it upsets her because she likes Josh. Also, she said that Brit and Jordan plan to confront Josh after the nominations that evening.
- After the Nominations: Jordan and Curtis (the nominees) are both in the bathroom discussing the public's votes. Jordan says that she doesn't get along with the others. Curtis feels there's a strong chance he'll be the one voted out next week. (To vote dial 1 (900) 740-1000 U.S. and 1 (900) 870-9846 (Canada)). Later that evening Brit and Jordan (with Jamie in tow) confront Josh in the bedroom. They told him that they think he is trying to bag both of them and is downplaying his feelings about one to the other. Josh answered that he doesn't want to cause any trouble for anyone, and will stay in his room from now on. Jordan said it is classic stud behaviour, and he's just trying to get laid (LOL - like she's not!). Josh apologized to both of them and said he felt certain ways and acted on him emotions.
- After the discussion, the other house guests support Josh and all feel kind of sorry for him.

- Later, Brit and Curtis hug on the couch. Curtis confides that he feels rejected because of the nomination. Brit tells him that he is handling the whole thing awesomely. Karen has a pep talk with Josh, and tells him she thinks he's been manipulated. Josh tells her that actually, he likes Jamie... Karen strongly advises him to not act on that feeling at all, or it will look like he's going after #3. Finally, some good advice from Karen.

Day 24 (Friday, July 28, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 24 is shown today. Eddie finally joined the love bed with Brittany and Jamie. Brit told him she's mad at him because he supported Josh after the confrontation went down between herself, Josh and Jordan. Eddie apologized to Brit, saying that she had the support of the others, and felt Josh needed someone to talk to. He doesn't believe Josh is selfish. In the Red Room, Josh tells BB that he's mad at Jordan because of her competitive attitude and her actions around Brit and Josh. He confides that he is usually quite confident around women, however, when he likes a woman, he becomes shy, like with Jamie. He doesn't want to hurt Brit though. Jordan cries to Jamie, telling her that Curtis really hurt her feelings by telling her that her actions were dramatic and ugly, after the first nominations. Jordan feels that Curtis is emotionally detached and said she misses her privacy and best friend. Later, the house guests split into teams and hold a water-balloon toss in the pool. The group work on the dominoes challenge, and Cassandra seems to hurt the challenge rather than help it, by continuously (accidentally) knocking down rows of dominoes. Later, Eddie is asked by BB to give George a surprise letter from his family. George becomes very emotional, and tells the group that since they have been so supportive of him, he would like to read them the letter from his eldest daughter, Jessica. While reading it, Josh and Brit both cry, while Curtis looks uncomfortable and almost bored. After, Josh cries very hard in the bedroom with Brit trying to console him. (There is absolutely no mention of the tennis balls/newspaper article on the TV show, for you Internet watchers). Curtis and Jordan once again discuss the banishment votes and both agree they want to know who voted for them. Jordan feels they have the right to know, however, Curtis said they have to suck it up and deal with it. The show ends with the group all trying to re-set the dominoes board for the challenge the next day.

Day 25 (Saturday, July 29, 2000) CBS Show

- A one hour special recaptures the past week (days 19-24 - see below for details). A few extra scenes that are shown on this episode are Brit offering room and board to Karen and her kids in Brit's duplex in Minneapolis, should Karen choose to leave her husband. Also, Curtis and Cassandra talk about possible alliances within the house and how the vote may go on Wednesday. Cass tells Curtis she thinks Jordan needs to chill out and stop being so aggressive and manipulative.
- Day 25 is then shown beginning with the successful completion of the dominoes challenge. The group wins 20% of the wagered grocery money. Later, Jordan asks Jamie what she would do if she became pregnant. Jamie reveals that she is very pro-choice, and it would be a difficult decision. She said that she is mature and financially secure to take care of a child, however, doesn't really want a child at this point in her life. She then said she wants to adopt kids and wants at least 3 of her own and 3 adopted children. Brit is shown in the Red Room telling BB that she does not trust Jordan and does not feel safe being open with her because she is vindictive and mean and doesn't consider others feelings. She said, however, that she does feel safe with Jamie, and Jamie has a good heart. Later, Brit tells the group that her father is very protective of her, and wonders what he thinks of her in the house. She said that she's learned a lot in the house, about ways to connect with people. She doesn't think she is very happy in her life outside of the house and doesn't feel like anything matters out there, (it was kind of sad really). Josh and Brit later talk privately, and Josh told her he doesn't want her to brush him off because of what happened earlier in the week, and that he feels stupid. Brit basically tells him that she doesn't want to hug him because of her feelings for him, and that it would just make it worse. Jamie's name is mentioned, and Josh tells Brit that if anything were to happen romantically between himself and Jamie, it would be after they leave the house. Eddie, while in the pool, tells Karen and Jamie

that he has an emotional side, however, left it at home. He said while in the house, he can not deal with emotions, but can deal with loneliness, and that he likes to observe. In the Red Room again, Brit cries while telling BB about how afraid she was when she thought George might leave the house when he read the letter from his daughter. She has a bond with George and feels that he would do anything for her should she need him. Much later, Eddie wakes up George at 4:00 a.m. to invite him to join the others who were all drinking. Curtis, Josh and Eddie all discuss the 3 girls, Jordan, Brit and Jamie, and Curtis advises Josh to stay away from them all. The conversation is a typical guy conversation (absolutely no sign of any of them being gay here). Brit and Karen are later shown standing on the table, with Eddie sitting on a chair also on the table. The show ends with everyone in the pool, and Eddie taking a bath in one of the red buckets.

Day 27 (Monday, July 31, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 26 and 27 were shown tonight. It's 5:00 a.m. and the house guests are having a BBQ. All seem to be pretty drunk, especially Brittany who was straddling Curtis and rubbing his face. Curtis seemed to enjoy the attention, while smoking a cigarette and saying how he's definitely going to be unemployed after he leaves the house. Brit and Jamie do a dance while Eddie pours beer on his head and dives into the pool. At 7:05 a.m. they are still awake and Karen is cleaning the kitchen. Brit asks Karen if she should still be upset with Josh after what happened last week. Karen said no. Brit then joins Josh under the covers lying on the couch and they hug. Brit tells Josh that she's still mad at him. Josh tells her he likes being there with her. Later, Eddie tells Cassandra that his girlfriend has a problem with his drinking and he doesn't like it. Cass advises Eddie to separate his drinking, socializing lifestyle from the time he spends with his girlfriend. Eddie later tells BB in the Red Room that he's found a new appreciation for his family. Later that day, George and Eddie try to brew their own beer, but make a mess of the kitchen. They try to hide it from Karen, who is peering at them through the door. Brit and Jordan later talk about Josh, and Jordan advises Brit to follow her feelings and give Josh a chance. That evening, Josh and Brit tease Jamie about liking Eddie. Eddie then comes out and they tease both of them. Eddie admits that Jamie and he are opposites, and it would never work, however, would be fun. Cassandra and Jamie have a private conversation that night, discussing the alliance that seems to have formed in the house, and how it bothers Jamie. She said she would never discuss her votes with anyone and doesn't think it's right to do that. The next day (Day 27), the house guests are given their weekly challenge. They must jump rope, six at a time, for 10 jumps. They agree to wager 30% of their grocery money, and begin practicing right away. They also must make up a song for the rope jumpers to sing while jumping. The show ends with Brit giving George a haircut.

Day 28 (Tuesday, August 1, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 27 & 28 are shown tonight. Cassandra asks Brit and Jordan what the purpose of the love bed is. Brittany explains that she likes the affection and the touch of another human being. Jordan said she is learning to be more affectionate with both sexes. Cass admitted she is not a touchy/feely person and likes her space. Jordan said she has difficulty separating affection from sex. Jordan later directs an aerobics class for Jamie, Curtis and Josh. Out in the backyard, all the house guests (minus Eddie) talk about Jordan's strip club and the dynamics of the place. Jordan tells them that she kept it quiet that she worked there and would always have to cover up what she does to the people who knew her. She said that she kind of misses stripping because it was a sense of control and empowerment. She said that she sometimes made \$200-250.00 per hour just to sit with a customer and provide company to him. Day 28 (1:20 am) Brit and Josh discuss their futures, and Josh said he doesn't know if he wants to go back to school. He said he doesn't let go of anything very easily. He also said he doubts the group will see much of each other after they all leave the house. Brit goes into the bathroom, talking to herself the whole way saying "don't do anything stupid" over and over again, and "control yourself - you're a human being". Brit later asks Karen about her conversation with Josh the other day, asking for details. Karen tells her that Josh

admitted to being attracted to Jamie. Karen, Cassandra and Curtis all talk about the father/son relationship that has formed between George and Eddie, and Karen nags on and on about how weird it is, etc. Later in the love bed, Brit whispers to Karen that she feels stupid and pathetic about the whole Josh thing. That day, the BB Roast is shown, where each of the house guests must say a stupid joke to both Curtis and Jordan (scripted by BB) as a farewell to them since one will leave the house the next day. After, Brit confronts Eddie about why he offered Jordan his place to crash if ever she's in New York. Eddie said he is trying to make amends with Jordan and wants to get along with her in the short time remaining in the house together. Jordan and Josh talk in the kitchen and Josh says he believes girls like to kiss more than have sex. He also said that he's straight even though sometimes he doesn't act it. He admitted to liking make-up and nail polish. The show ends with Brit and Curtis doing some kind of silly dance. It appears the drinking has picked up lately...

Day 29 (Wednesday, August 2, 2000) CBS Live Banishment Show 2

- Julie Chen opened the show with clips of Jordan and the games she has been playing since walking into the house. Clips were also shown of the house guests talking about Jordan in a negative manner. Eddie and George were shown again talking about Curtis looking down on George, and lawyers being sharks. The house guests were shown live sitting in the living room, with Eddie and Josh dressed as chipendale dancers. Both Jordan and Curtis had their bags packed and by the front door. Jordan reminded everyone that it's her birthday today (she's 27). Julie suddenly told Curtis to go to the Red Room. Everyone looked really confused. Curtis went into the Red Room and very shortly thereafter, returned with a birthday cake for Jordan, which included a picture of her face on the cake. A bottle of champagne was also included with the cake. Jordan said she looked like Beavis. Julie then showed us what it is like for the house guests to constantly be followed by the live cameras strategically placed all over the house. Jordan's boyfriend, Ben, her sister, Elizabeth and best friend Anne, were in the studio and Julie asked Ben what his prediction was for the banishment. Ben said he believes Jordan will survive tonight's banishment and make it quite far in the process. Curtis' older brother is also in the studio and he told Julie that he doesn't think Curtis has developed deep relationships yet with his peers and thinks he will be voted out tonight. Julie then announced to the viewing public (not the house guests) that Jordan received 78% of the votes and Curtis received 22%. Dr. Drew Pinsky is interviewed as usual, and said that he believes America is voting out the people that bring instability to the house. He thinks that Jordan plays too many games and exhibits glee from those games. He also thinks that if she is voted out, the house guests will miss her because of her strong presence in the house. Julie then went live to the house guests and announced that Jordan has been voted out. She is given 3 minutes to say her goodbyes. One by one, she hugged everyone, gathered up her backpack and her air pool float and headed to the front door. Once outside, she hugged everyone again. I was quite surprised that she didn't cry. Her loyal boyfriend, Ben, greeted her at the gate and hugged and kissed her with much enthusiasm. She told him that she missed him and that she was excited to be out of the house. Inside the house, the guests congratulated Curtis. Jordan headed to the studio for her interview with Julie, and received a standing ovation from the audience. She looked like she was lapping it up. When asked how she was feeling, she responded by saying that she feels foreign, and that living in the house was like being in another world. She said that the house was dysfunctional and that they were set up to bond as a family, yet had to stab each other in the back every 2 weeks. She was then shown clips of herself over the past 4 weeks, including the games she played and the relationship with Josh and Brittany. Jordan said that she feels that there was a slant put on the editing and that it was not the full story, and was very negative. At that point, I think Julie should have challenged her on that and reminded her that we see her 24/7, however, Julie said nothing (just my opinion). Julie asked her if she was truly interested in Josh, and Jordan said she was attracted to him but not enough to leave her boyfriend. When asked if she would have responded to Josh had he made an advance, Jordan said she would not have, (yeah, right)! The nominations were then shown to Jordan so that she could see who voted for her. Next,

the stripclub that Jordan works in in Minneapolis, Schieks Palace, was shown with the Club Manager saying that she believes that Jordan would not have been a guest on Big Brother if it were not for her work at the club. Some other dancers were then shown and all of them said they think Jordan will be back working at the club. Jordan then said she would not be going back there to work; only to clean out her locker. Julie asked Jordan if she would consider posing nude, and Jordan took her time answering the question. She said she would consider it but the possibility of saying yes is highly unlikely. Julie then brought up the time when Jordan cried in the Red Room about the time she told her parents about her job. Julie told her that her parents were invited to the studio tonight, however, did not come. A scene from David Letterman was then shown, and Jordan was told that she has been invited on the show. Jordan said she would go for sure. The show ended with the guys sitting around the pool talking about something unrelated to Jordan.

Day 30 (Thursday, August 3, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opens with Karen running into the toilet room crying, we're not sure why.
- We then see Karen talking with other houseguests. She is very upset with George's behaviour at the roast last night. She calls him "a little sh*t". She then turns to Eddie who she calls an a-hole because of his 180degree turn at the roast, "He was all disrespectful to me and then he comes up with that BS!"
- We then see George in the bedroom. He is upset and says the problem with being in the house is that you can't have a good time, "you always gotta cover your butt!"
- Karen, Cassandra, Jamie and Brittany all talking in the bedroom. They all agree that the house would be better with just girls and then they all agree that they "now have a plan".
- Now we see George outside, talking to the camera, "You guys set me up! You're just trying to get me thrown out! You hung me out to dry!" He's obviously upset.
- We see Karen talking to Eddie, talking about how George is like a follower. She wanted to cook, then he started to cook. She became friends with Brit, then he had to. Eddie lightly defends him and says he just admires Karen.
- Now we see Karen running into the toilet area again (same shot as the intro of the show). Brit follows and consoles her she cries, "I just want to get out of here, I can't deal with it. I'm so gossipy, that's not me!" She exits into the general bathroom area where Jamie and Brit help her fix her makeup and stuff. Eddie comes along and they hug at which time Eddie says "I love you Karen" and she responds with an "I love you too".
- The 3 girls go into the corner of the garden, where they think the cameras can't see them (but they can) and talk. George comes along with some tea and Karen apologizes to him, he just shrugs it off as no big deal.
- Next morning they're all talking about Jordan. Brit discloses that Jordan used to stand in front of the cameras nude and lotion herself up, and put on just a thong and parade around the room in front of the cameras!
- The show ends with an unusual scene. We see Joshua standing in front of the bathroom mirror getting ready. He is holding a razor and appears to have just finished shaving his chest. He rubs his chest a lot especially his nipples and in the final shot he licks his finger wet and rubs his nipple with it!

Day 31 (Friday, August 4, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opens with Brittany talking "I've decided to make the leap, I will be going all out!"
- We see Cassandra and Jamie talking about Jordan. Cassandra feels that there's nobody left in the house that causes ripples and Curtis has gotten closer to everyone since his nomination.
- Eddie, Joshua and Brittany talking sex in the bedroom. Brittany brings up virginity, and makes her statement again about going all out. Joshua states that he's never been into toys and things, he just likes 2 nude bodies. Brittany is smiling and staring at Joshua intensely the whole time. Joshua admits that he has not had a wet dream even though

he thinks he should have by now, Eddie confides that he thought he was going to have one the other night but didn't.

- Suddenly the camera turns and you can hear it make that familiar whining, motor sound. Brittany whispers "I like the noises that they make!", everyone laughs knowing she's comparing it to the sound of a vibrator. "I like that, the whole body reaction to it...oh no, I'm so embarrassed!" she explains as she buries her head into the pillow, afraid that she's said too much.
- Next we get a small commentary by Karen in the RedRoom with small clips of the house guests as she's talking. She says she sees a different side of Brit lately. They show Brit dancing around Joshua and Jamie suntanning, she is obviously teasing Joshua and pours water on him to get a reaction. "She's jealous of them, I see that in her now. If I was her mother I would not pick Joshua for her". Brittany's actions seem to coincide with Karen's statements.
- A quick clip of Eddie in the bedroom with George and Joshua shows Eddie talking about not being to go to the washroom. When he stands up the other two are disgusted and George goes "We didn't have to see that Eddie!"
- We then hear Brit talking to Jamie and Karen about the same subject. "Eddie's got to learn to keep his pants on. I mean, I've see 'it' like 5 times!" Eddie happens onto the conversation and tells Brit she's imagining things.
- Now we get a clip of Joshua and Brit on the couch, playing with each others hands as they talk. Karen comes along and starts to lecture him on being this way with Brittany, says she's worried that Brittany will get hurt. Interesting mother/child overtones in this clip.
- As the day progresses we get to Eddie and Brit at night. Brit's speech is slurred, I suspect she's been drinking or is VERY tired. Eddie is stroking her hair repeatedly as she's laying in bed and they are talking about her family being ashamed of her. Eddie reassures her that her father is probably very proud. He leaves but not after Brit asks for a kiss goodnight, which he gives her on the lips.
- The show ends with Jamie, Curtis, Karen and George sitting around the picnic table talking about Jordan's departure. Karen says that even though she likes Eddie, she would pick Curtis over him if they were the nominees. George is playing solitaire, not wanting to get in on the conversation and the other just look dumbfounded.

Day 32 (Saturday, August 5, 2000) CBS Show

- The first half hour of the show was repeats of highlights that happened throughout the week. The show opened with George pretending to stab himself with a knife, and telling the camera he is going crazy in the house. The second half hour showed Karen, Jamie and Brittany in the love bed with Eddie on the floor. Jamie tried to encourage Eddie to join the love bed, but Eddie said no, stating that there is too much estrogen in the bed and they are looking for trouble. After more persuasion and Brittany talking in a bedroom voice, Cassandra woke up and kicked Eddie out of the room. Friday (Day 31) is shown, with Karen and George discussing the next nominations. Karen told George she believes he will be spared from a nomination. Jamie and Curtis are shown talking in the bedroom about Karen and how she is always talking about people. Jamie told Curtis that it makes her very uncomfortable and she doesn't like it. At noon, the group tried to win their jump rope challenge to win 30% more of their weekly grocery money. The challenge is for six of them to jump rope ten times together, with two people turning the rope and chanting a song, written by the group. Josh and Jamie successfully jumped into the rope, however, when it became George's turn, he mis-stepped and stopped the rope. The group automatically lost the challenge and 30% of their weekly grocery allowance. George instantly felt terrible about losing the challenge, and was visibly upset about it, even though all the housemates told him not to worry about it.
- Later, Brit talks to Jamie about Josh again, and told her she feels terrible about involving the whole house in their "affair" and doesn't want to jeopardize her status in the house for Josh. Cassandra is shown in the Red Room telling BB that she doesn't want to get involved in the house drama, and is happy with a quiet corner and decent nights sleep. Karen and George talk about the missed challenge, with George telling her that he's sure he will get nominated out of the house now for screwing up the jump

rope. Karen tried to tell him that she doesn't believe that to be true, but he was beating himself up so bad, he couldn't hear her. Brittany is later shown in the Red Room, talking about, guess what...Josh, again.

- She confessed to BB that she can't handle the whole situation anymore with Josh and will be nominating him for banishment on Wednesday night. Later that evening, she is shown sitting with Josh on the couch, playing with his hand. She told him that she is really physically attracted to him now but questions his integrity and honesty because of what happened in the past. Josh seemed genuinely hurt that she said she didn't know if she could trust him, but at the same time, seemed to understand. They made a pact that they would remain as friends only and that nothing will happen between them while in the house. They also agreed that they don't want to be isolated from the other houseguests, which was beginning to happen. George is then shown in the Red Room, asking BB how the voluntary exit works. He continuously kicked himself in the head and told BB he is worried about Eddie and the others getting enough food. The show ended with the group successfully completing the jump rope challenge for fun only.

Day 34 (Monday, August 7, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 32 was shown tonight. Curtis and Jamie once again talked privately about Karen, and her past problems with Curtis being friends with Jordan when Jordan was in the house. They talked about how shallow she can be at times, and how she is very anti-Josh these days. Jamie confessed to Curtis that she will nominate Karen for banishment on Wednesday. She thinks Karen is too quick to judge everyone in the house. Day 33 is then shown, with Karen crying to Brittany about not receiving a letter from her kids. She was worried about what they think of her. Brit tried to comfort her, and told her that she knows they love her and will write soon.
- Jamie whispers to George, who is in the bedroom with Eddie. She was teasing Eddie to George, saying that Eddie acts differently around her than he acts with Brit. George told Jamie that she is very pretty and an attractive person. Eddie told her she's a pain in the ass! Jamie asked Eddie why he touches Brit and teases Brit but doesn't touch her? Eddie would not answer her right then but told her maybe he would answer that later.
- Later, the group talk about relationships and why, quite often, beautiful women are seen with older, not so attractive men, but not vice versa. Karen reminisces on her earlier dating years and how much fun it was. Eddie participates in the conversation by yelling from the bedroom, and tells everyone that he dated a 30 year old last year. Cassandra confesses that she hasn't dated for a year, and is not open to it. Eddie starts a conversation about the length of a man's penis, and asks everyone if they prefer an ugly guy with a 9" penis, or a gorgeous guy with a 1" penis. Karen prefers 9", Brit prefers 9" but said it's not necessary if the guy is really nice; Cass disagrees with her. Curtis said he'd rather be ugly with a 9" penis. Jamie wouldn't answer the question.
- Later, Josh and Brit are alone once again, washing dishes and talking about their pact and how successful it is so far. Curtis is shown in the Red Room telling BB how wonderful Jamie is, and how he thinks she is trustworthy and not a pushover or shy girl that they all believed her to be at first. He said that he is very attracted to Jamie, and considers her a good friend, however would not pursue anything in the house but possibly would after. Karen talks to Cassandra and Brit about how worried she is about her kids. She told them she is especially worried about Ashley and the way her husband treats Ashley at times. Karen said her husband will yell at Ashley right into her face to intimidate her, and that she is worried he might hit her. She also said she thinks he's insane.
- Day 34 is then shown, with the houseguests receiving their weekly challenge. They must participate in a pie-eating contest, splitting into two teams, the Blueberries and the Raspberries, and must make the pies themselves. On Friday, at noon, each team of 4 must eat 8 pies, with each member eating at least one whole pie each and the others making up the difference. They have to keep their hands behind their backs and eat with their mouth only. The challenge must be completed within 30 minutes. Karen told them her kids were in a pie-eating contest and they puked in the pie. The group agrees

to wager 20% of their grocery money on this challenge. That night, Brittany cries to Cassandra and Jamie about how she feels that she is not understood in the house. Cass gives her a pep talk as usual. Eddie is shown in the Red Room telling BB that he is planning on talking to Jamie that night about her crush on him. He admitted to being attracted to Jamie, but said nothing will happen and he is not interested because of his girlfriend, Monica. The show ends with Curtis and Josh prancing around in the girls shoes.

Day 35 (Tuesday, August 8, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 34. Eddie was laying on Brittany on the bed, telling her to say "Eddie's great". A pillow fight then ensued, followed by wrestling and Eddie hitting Brit with her shoe. Finally, Brit told Eddie he won, and Eddie stood on the bed and yelled "the lovebed is now the bed of hatred and destruction".
- Cassandra is shown in the Red Room telling BB that she likes and respects everyone in the house, however, is not going to hug them or sleep in the lovebed, because she wouldn't do that outside of the house. Cass said that she thinks a crisis is going to occur to those who need attention when those they lean on are kicked out of the house. Later, Jamie cornered Eddie in the bedroom and asked him why he acts weird around her. Eddie told her he is comfortable teasing and hugging Brittany because he feels differently about her than he does about Jamie. He said that he could see him and Jamie together outside of the house, if not for his girlfriend Monica. Therefore, he treats Jamie differently inside the house. Jamie told him she wants to bond with everyone in the house and would never get involved with anyone romantically. She asked Eddie to please treat her the same as he would anyone else. Eddie responded that he doesn't walk on eggshells for anyone.
- Day 35 - Curtis and Cassandra discussed the upcoming nominations and agreed that there would be feelings of guilt and betrayal amongst the house guests. Curtis told Cass he feels that he can talk to her and Jamie when he is down. Cass said that everyone has to face reality and that this is just a game. Later, Curtis told BB in the Red Room that he believes the voting blocks have changed slightly now that Jordan is gone. He believes that Josh may get nominated this time.
- Brittany delivers a long-awaited letter to Karen from her kids. Karen tearfully reads the letter from her daughter, Ashley, to the house guests, as well as a short note from her son, Nathan. Both kids told her they love her and want her to continue on in the house. Later, Jamie and George talked privately in the bedroom about Karen, and Jamie confessed that she believes Karen to be showing false affection and is quite two-faced. She also said she doesn't think it is good to be so open in front of the group about which way you will vote. George said he is having a real problem dealing with all of this. They both agreed that they will both keep those they feel have a big heart.
- BB gave the house guests another challenge. They acted out a mock talk-show, each playing a role that was opposite to their real character. Karen played the host, Karen Springer, and Eddie played the first guest, married to Cassandra, a professional wrestler. The show was on secrets, and Cassandra confessed to Eddie that she is having an affair with George, playing a lowly, tearful geek. Then Cass admits to being a man. Next, Curtis, playing a loud-mouthed, crazy guy, joins the panel and tells the audience that he and Eddie are Siamese twins separated at birth. Next, Jamie joins the group saying that she is a country girl, and her secret is she is Eddie's mistress. Then, Brittany joins in, telling everyone that her and Jamie are having a lesbian affair. Brit's last secret is that she is actually an alien. Josh played the security guard and held Eddie back a few times when he blew up. It was actually pretty entertaining.
- Cassandra is shown in the Red Room after the mock talk show, telling BB that she was very uncomfortable with the role she was given to play, and felt that it portrayed black Americans poorly. She felt that it showed black women as gum-chewing, loud-mouthed people and doesn't think it's right playing into racist thoughts. The show ended with a reminder that Wednesday is banishment night, (can't wait).

Day 36 (Wednesday, August 9, 2000) CBS Live Nomination Show 3

- The live show opened with Julie Chen advising the house guests that a phone had been installed in the Red Room, and that one house guest would be granted a 1 minute phone call to anyone of their choice. The person who would be granted the call will be decided by the house guests as a group. They were then given 3 minutes to decide who the lucky one would be. Right away, Josh and Jamie both said they don't want to be considered. It came down to Karen and George because they both have kids. Karen agreed that since she just received letters from her kids, George should get the call. All agreed.
- Brittany's family and friends were shown in a Minneapolis bar celebrating Brit's stay in the BB house. Her friends told BB that they don't believe Brit and Josh would ever get together in the outside world. All of her family and friends seemed to be very supportive and proud of her.
- George gets to make his phone call to his wife, Theresa, in the Red Room. As soon as he picked up the phone, Theresa told him not to speak, and then spent the following 50 seconds telling George how proud she is of him, and how she and the kids want him to stay in "summer camp" and to stay focussed. She then told him his niece had a baby. All George said to her, with 7 seconds left, was "Theresa, the people are so nice in here". After the call, George loses it and cries at the door of the Red Room. He then joins the house guests to tell them what Theresa had said to him.
- A new house guest was introduced to the group tonight. Karen was asked to go into the Red Room to introduce herself to the new member, and bring her to meet the others. Karen entered the room to find a pug named Chiquita, who is not fully house-trained, suffers from a gas problem, and loves burritos. All of the house guests seemed very happy to have Chiquita in the house.
- BB introduced a new structure tonight. From now on, each house guest will be notified of how many votes for banishment they receive during voting night. Dr. Drew Pinsky was interviewed about this new format and felt that it will cause extra tension for the guests, and will shatter any complacency they may feel. They will all realize they are at risk for banishment now, and it will cause trust issues within the house. Dr. Pinsky also felt that adding Chiquita to the mix will add an interesting dynamic for those house guests that have caretaking instincts.
- The house guests were each shown in the Red Room announcing their nominations:
 - Cassandra - Karen & Brittany
 - Eddie - Curtis & Jamie
 - Karen - Josh & Cassandra
 - Curtis - Eddie & Josh
 - George - Cassandra & Josh
 - Brittany - Cassandra & Josh
 - Josh - Curtis & Karen
 - Jamie - Karen & Josh
 - Josh 5, Cassandra 3, Karen 3, Curtis 2, Brittany 1, Eddie 1, Jamie 1, George 0
- After the nominations were made known, Josh, Cassandra and Karen all looked upset, with Karen looking especially peeved at the group. Josh and Brittany took Chiquita outside, and the dog jumped in the pool. Josh jumped in, fully clothed, to save her. Karen joined the others outside and told Brit and Jamie that she knows who voted for her, and feels like she's been kicked in the balls. Since there was a tie for second place, all 3 will be up for banishment this week. We all have one week to phone in with our votes... I wonder who will go next Wednesday?

Day 37 (Thursday, August 10, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 35 is shown with Karen smoking her last cigarette and telling the house guests she is quitting beginning tomorrow.
- Day 36 is then shown with Jamie and Brit talking about Josh being a model. Brit told Jamie that she couldn't see it before, but can now. They then talked about all the house guests and who they find attractive in the house. Later, all the guests sitting in the living room discuss Karen's personal life. Karen told them that she wants a big, passionate kiss when she leaves the house. Her husband hates kissing or any kind of touch. She said she will file for a divorce after the house, and hopes to start dating.

Brit talked to George, and offered to be a role model to his daughters. George told her that he feels his daughters can relate to Brit and like her. Jamie was shown lying on the couch with her head on Eddie's lap. Curtis and Brit were lying on the other couches, and Eddie was teaching Brit how to talk like a New Yorker. Later, Karen and Brit have a wrestling match with George acting as the referee. After much laughing and struggling, Karen took Brit down and won the match.

- Day 37 - Brit talked to Jamie about her ex-boyfriend, and how they almost had sex, but then didn't because he was nervous about it being Brit's first time. She said they fought on and off until they broke up, and now she's happy they didn't have sex. Karen later talked privately to Brit and Jamie about the 3 nominations she received. She had no idea Jamie had nominated her, and went on and on about who she knows nominated her (Cass, Curtis and Josh). Jamie just sat there and didn't admit it was her who nominated Karen. Karen said that she thinks Cass has been working on Curtis all week, and knows what she's doing.
- Karen takes Curtis into the washroom later that day and they talk about the nominations. Curtis told her it's not ethical for him to tell her who he voted for, but shared how he got through being nominated last week. He told Karen not to take it personally, and he would like to continue to hang out with her and be close to her this upcoming week. Jamie walked in and interrupted their discussion. They went silent until after she left, and remained silent after. The group is shown making pies for their challenge on Friday. Karen is shown in the Red Room crying about the nominations, again, and saying how she realizes how needy she is. Eddie is outside in the backyard talking to Chiquita in Chiquita's language. The dog seems to fear Eddie. There was no mention of Josh's reaction to his 5 nominations. BB will not be on TV on Friday night, but returns for a 1 hour episode on Saturday night.

Day 39 (Saturday, August 12, 2000) CBS Show

- Reruns from the week were shown during the first half of the show. A lot of the focus was on Karen and how badly she has taken the three nominations she received on Wednesday night. The new episode focussed on Day 38, and began with Curtis and Cassandra discussing the nominations. Curtis told Cass that he feels his relationship with Karen is over since she believes he nominated her (he didn't). Josh, who is also having difficulty dealing with his five nominations, was shown sitting by himself most of the time, in a "funk". Brittany cries in Eddie's arms while he lay in bed, telling him she feels terribly guilty about Josh being nominated.
- Karen told Brit and Curtis that she wants to be banished from the house on Wednesday, because she doesn't want to go through this again. Curtis told her that ultimately, the decision is up to the public, and it's really how Karen conducts herself 24/7 that will determine her fate. Curtis is shown in the Red Room telling BB that he feels it is unfair for Karen to condemn him for something he didn't even do. Jamie and Brittany talk privately about how weird the house has been since the nominations were announced. Brit said that she thinks Curtis nominated her (he didn't), and Jamie said she thinks Eddie nominated her (he did). Both believe either Josh or Karen will be voted out because of how badly they are dealing with their nominations.
- Later, Brittany cries to Josh, and asks him how he is feeling about his fate. He told her he's dealing with it in his own way. He also said for her not to worry about him, and not to look at him any different - he's still the same person. Josh feels that it is an opportunity to be a better person. Brittany later cries to Eddie again. She told him she doesn't understand his feelings towards Jamie, i.e. whether he likes Jamie to date, or not. Eddie told her it's up to her to figure it out. Karen interrupts them, and tells them both she is ready to leave the house. She said she was there for the experience, and feels that she has gotten that, and it's been as good as it will get. She wants to see her kids and feels too crazy and unsettled to stay any longer. She also said that George makes her crazy and is a "f***ing idiot sometimes".
- The three nominated guests are given 30 seconds each to plead their cases to the public, on why they should stay in the house. Cassandra goes first and says that she wants to stay with the group, is enjoying getting to know them, and feels that she brings stability to the house. Josh goes next, saying outside of the house he studies and

works all the time, and he is in the house to have a good time. It's up to America whether he stays or not. Karen is last, saying her kids are her #1 priority and she is homesick for them - so if they want her out, please vote her out. 90% of her wants to be banished.

- The pie-eating contest is shown next. The eight guests are divided into two teams, raspberries and blueberries, and must eat eight pies between the four of them that they baked themselves during the week. Their hands are held behind their backs, and they each must eat at least one pie each. Josh throws up twice in a bucket beside him, but keeps going. Eddie told him he can't wait to drink with him on the outside. The Raspberries end up winning, and therefore, get to determine the grocery list for the upcoming week. All of them receive 20% more grocery money because of the success of the challenge.

Day 41 (Monday, August 14, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 39 is shown, with George telling BB in the Red Room that, since Karen' temper tantrum regarding the nominations, his thoughts have changed about her. He said he finds he is more reserved around her now, more guarded about what he will tell her, and believes that she does not deal with stress well. Later, Brittany dyed George's hair blonde. That was only the first step; the second step was dying it blue. When asked if he liked George's new look, Eddie replied that it brings out the color of George's eyes. George repeated over and over, "I kind of like it"... George and Eddie shared their regular night-time chat, with George telling Eddie he doesn't believe he'll get a job in construction once these days are over. Eddie agreed, calling George a blue-haired freak/roofer.
- Day 40 - Jamie dyed Brit's hair green, while George and Josh (with a new nickname "Sloshy") finished making the home-made wine. Sloshy tested the wine, and told George it was very good. George tested it and didn't think so. The group was given their next weekly challenge (#6). It was called the Interstate Road Trip, and the house guests were provided with a map of the U.S. and told that they must memorize all the interstate routes between major cities. On Friday at noon, they will be asked to name the highways between certain major cities. Karen told the group that this challenge will be easy for her, however, she won't be in the house on Friday, so it's not up to her. No one replied to Karen's comment. After some discussion, the group agreed to wager 20% of their grocery money.
- That evening, Brit gave both Curtis and Josh hair highlights. Later, Cassandra and Curtis talked privately out at the pool. Cass told Curtis that she's not too upset about being nominated, that she does think about it, however, is not stressed about it. She also said that she believes she will be the one to leave the house on Wednesday, due to the generation gap between her and the young ones in the house. She believes that the public will consider her expendable because she has no niche in the house, is not loveable like Karen and Josh, and could be seen as quite cold due to her lack of interaction with the other house guests.
- After quite a bit of drinking the home-made wine, Josh and Karen discuss the differences in being 23 years old (Josh) and 43 years old (Karen). Karen told him that at 43, she really knows that what is right and wrong is not the only answer, and that life is short, therefore, she has begun to justify things and has become selfish. After asking Josh if she could be blatantly honest with him, she told him that it was his inconsistency with the Brit/Jordan scene that bothered her about him. Jamie interrupted the two's discussion with hugs and kisses goodnight. When she left, Josh confessed to Karen that he has never met anyone in his entire life as much like him as Jamie is. Every day he tries to hide his feelings and pushes it away. He wishes that it was only Jamie he had shown interest in from the beginning. He said that he told everyone he looks at Jamie as a sister to take away any attention from her, however, feels that he belongs with Jamie.
- At bedtime, Karen used the toilet leaving the door open for Brit and Cass to watch her. Both laughed and closed the door, reminding Karen about the Internet cameras. Karen continued to push the door open over and over again. She then came out, dropped her

pants to her ankles and mooned America. Brit walked away laughing, and told Cass Karen is now her responsibility.

- Day 41 - Cass and Eddie talked about the nominations, and Eddie said that everyone always thinks he nominated them. Cass said she doesn't think they will make it through the next 6 weeks the way they've been going, and thinks everyone will self-destruct. Eddie said Jamie told him he should not have nominated her, and that you should only nominate the people that would nominate you. The group later discusses careers and Brittany told everyone that she has really proven herself at work, however, if she were to show up with pink hair, she'd be fired. George said he has hired many people with tattoos, piercings and even jailbirds. All people need to be given a chance. The show ends with the group eating dinner in fast forward mode, with Chiquita begging for food.

Day 42 (Tuesday, August 15, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 41 and 42 were shown on tonight's show. Karen was in the Red Room telling BB that she now thinks that maybe Curtis did not nominate her, and is worried that it could have been Eddie. She said that she has felt a certain loyalty to Eddie and would be troubled if she heard that it was him after she left the house. I think she may have been a little "tipsy".
- Day 42 - Brit, Karen, George and Curtis had a long conversation around the kitchen table about relationships. Brit told them that she thinks it's strange that she's 25 years old and has never been very close to a man. She has lots of friends that only remember past boyfriends and don't have many girl-friends, and she doesn't want to be like that. Karen said she thinks she married her "father" by marrying her husband. She told Brit that Brit needs a nurturer to fall in love with. Later, Brit floated in the pool on a blow-up "thing" while Curtis sat on the edge. Brit told him she would never marry someone who is not educated, has financial issues, smokes pot, or drinks regularly. Curtis responded that she could marry him, and then joined her on the very small float. They snuggled together while Brit told him she wants someone who really wants her.
- That evening, Josh lay in his bed with Brit beside him on the floor. He asked her if he could sleep in the girls room that night, and Brit said yes. While Josh stroked Brit's hair, she told him she's glad she met him, and doesn't want him to act weird around her. She told him she really wants to find a soul mate. Josh said she has a quality he really likes in girls; she's spontaneous, yet her feet are grounded. The next scene shows Brit in bed with Josh. Brit told him when she falls in love, it will happen really fast because she is a very emotional person.
- Josh is shown in the Red Room telling BB that he feels the whole thing with Brit is over and they are really good friends. They are too different for anything romantic to happen. He thinks though that Jamie and him will become closer now, and he would like to get to know Jamie outside of the house. The group participated in a game of water basketball in the pool. Two teams consisting of Eddie, George, Brit and Jamie on one, and Josh, Karen, Curtis and Cass on the other. They all appeared to have a great time, however, the pool was way too small for such a game.
- That evening, the group is given their second BB Roast, to honor Cass, Karen and Josh. Cass mainly received UN jokes, Josh received "sloshy" and playboy jokes, and Karen received mother and mooning jokes. George made a joke about Josh saying he should write a book about how to date two women in an 1800 square foot house and lose \$500,000. George laughed so hard he almost fell over. Eddie then made a joke about Karen, Brit and Jamie being b****s, in relation to the dog. The last joke shown, was Jamie saying something about Josh getting Brit "off". Cass looked quite upset by the end, and was shown after complaining that the roast is to make fun of the nominees, and the other house guests should not be dragged into it. Curtis suggested that they all ban together, try to hang out and lift each others spirits.
- George, Brit, and Curtis were shown in the Red Room one at a time, answering the question posed by BB "if you could change your nominations, who would you change". George said he would change his nomination of Cassandra to Karen. He said it's obvious Cass really wants to be in the house, and Karen does not. Curtis said he would change his nomination of Josh to Karen. Brit said she would change her nomination of Josh to

George, because she felt bad Josh received so many votes, and George received none and wouldn't have been in any jeopardy of being nominated for banishment. Later, Brit made sure to tell George what she had said to BB and why, in case the editing showed her words with the wrong slant. George told her not to worry about it.

Day 43 (Wednesday, August 16, 2000) CBS Live Banishment Show 3

- The live show opened with Julie Chen advising the house guests that a TV has been brought into their living room to provide a great surprise. If the house guests wanted to get the surprise, which apparently they will all love, they must first watch the Red Room nominations from last week. They were given 3 minutes to decide as a group what they wanted to do (majority rules). Immediately, all of them, except Eddie said they did not want to watch the Red Room tape because there is already too much conflict, and that would add to it. Eddie said, for the record, that he would like to watch the tape, but majority overruled, and they declined the surprise.
- Julie then focussed on Karen and played clips of the past 43 days, showing Karen discussing her bad marriage, her work around the house, being a Mom to the house guests, conflicts with George and some others, the letters from her kids and her last week in the house. Back in the BB house, the three up for banishment, Josh, Cassandra and Karen, were each given 30 seconds to express their feelings about leaving the house. Josh went first, telling everyone that he will have a good time whether in the house, or back at home, and that he has family in both places. Cass said she hopes to stay and will be sad to go. She will miss everyone and cares about them all. Karen cried and said she loves everyone, but wants to be banished. She said she is excited to leave and watch them when she is out.
- Julie then showed clips of Cassandra, focussing on her withdrawal from the group. Cassandra's Red Room clip was shown where she told BB that she is not comfortable with the touchy/feely thing, the love bed and the drinking parties. Julie then interviewed Dr. Drew Pinsky and asked him what he thought of Cass. Dr. Pinsky said that he believes Cass is honest, and has set great boundaries. She is very direct and mature. He was also not surprised the house guests declined watching the Red Room nominations, since it would be too destructive. He said he was moved by the 30 second speeches and it provides closure to the three nominees. Julie pointed out that all four women nominated Josh for banishment, and then showed clips of Josh in the house focussing on his inconsistency with Brit, Jordan and Jamie.
- Julie then spoke with the Internet spokeswoman who advised everyone that the Internet has been very busy this past week, and that most of the talk has been about Karen. A poll was ran regarding who would be the most affected by the new dog, Chiquita, and Brit ran away with the prize at 41%. Jamie came in last at 3%
- Julie went live to the house guests to inform them of the public's decision on who should be banished. Julie began with Josh, saying his name, then pausing for 10 seconds. Josh looked around in confusion, thinking he was the one chosen to leave, and began to stand up. Julie finished her sentence, saying "Josh, you received 9% of the votes". Josh looked relieved. Julie then went on to say that it was a landslide in Cass' favor, and that Karen received 76% of the votes leaving Cass with only 15%. Karen cried, and hugged everyone one at a time. She looked happy that she was the chosen one. All escorted her out the door, and after more hugging and crying, Karen walked down the path and ran into the arms of her two daughters. Jamie was very busy waving to the very large crowd gathered in the parking lot, to pay much attention to Karen, however, the others seemed quite pleased that Karen finally got to hug her kids. When the guests went back inside, they all hugged Cass and Josh and talked about how huge the crowd had become outside.
- Karen entered the studio, and hugged her two sons. She then told Julie she is ecstatic to see her kids and just wants to be a mom. Julie asked her if the house was what she was expecting, and Karen replied that she thought it would be fun, but it was quite stressful and boring at times. She could never get away from the people in there and the Red Room was a nightmare. She never knew how the public was going to view her. Julie then showed her clips of the past 43 days as Karen watched, both crying and laughing. Julie then brought up the issue of the three nominations Karen received and

how Karen believed one of them came from Curtis. Karen immediately said she knows it was Jamie that nominated her because of her missing her kids so badly. She feels bad about accusing Curtis. Karen was then shown the Red Room clip of Curtis saying how he felt about Karen accusing him. Karen said that she thinks she appeared harsher and cruder on TV than she usually is, and that by the end she could not deal with being in the house anymore. Lack of cigarettes and sleep, plus no more dawn BBQs added to that feeling.

- Julie then told Karen that her husband, Tom, was in the studio, and asked Karen if she wanted to see him. Karen immediately said yes, and Tom came out to greet her. They hugged and kissed many times and genuinely looked happy to see each other. Karen was then given the opportunity to say goodbye to the house guests again. She told them Tom was there, and George said "I told you so", and Brit and Jamie did not look impressed. Karen apologized to Curtis for accusing him of nominating her, and then told Jamie she knows she was the one and is okay with it.
- The show ended with the house guests talking about how the dynamics of the house will now change again. Eddie asked for everyone's attention, and then told them that four people had come to him over the past week to ask if he nominated them for banishment. He said they then declined to see the nominations tape... They all made an agreement that they would not share who they nominated for, and therefore, should not ask each other the question. Curtis agreed, saying that as the group gets smaller, it will become harder to nominate two people. Nominations should not be taken personally and should not be discussed. Everyone will find out who nominated them when they are voted out of the house. They are there to enjoy each other's company and have fun.
- BB will not be on TV Thursday night, and the one-hour live episode next week will be on Thursday night rather than Wednesday night due to the two-hour finale of Survivor.

Day 44 (Thursday, August 17, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 43 is shown, with Jamie and Josh out at the pool. Jamie told Josh that Brit is very upset and wants the two of them to talk about what's bothering her. The three go into the bedroom, and Brit accused Josh of lying to her, and told him that Karen had told her what Josh had said about his feelings towards both Brit and Jamie... That he liked Brit as a friend, however, was interested in Jamie. Josh didn't understand why Brit was so upset, so Brit tried to explain to him how she felt when Karen told her these things. She felt that Josh should have told her himself. Josh said that there is no substance to it because nothing is going on between him and Jamie, and therefore, nothing to tell. Josh said he spends so much time outside at the pool, so as not to come between Brit and Jamie's friendship. He said he has never lied to Brit and cares very much about her. Brit said she wants to believe him, and feels like a total sucker. She then cried very hard into her pillow, while Jamie tried to comfort her. Josh sat looking at the two very confused and visibly upset.
- Later, Jamie talked to Curtis, saying she can't figure out Eddie. She said that Eddie told her he sometimes feels jealous of Josh because Josh gets all the women's attention in the house. She said he is very focused on winning the money and doesn't want to get to know people, but every now and then opens up to her. She felt that she made a mistake opening up to him and getting close to him. Curtis said that Eddie has always been honest about his feelings. Eddie is then shown in the Red Room telling BB that maybe he's a heartless b**tard and thinks that it is crazy in the house. He said that BB knows his weaknesses, and doesn't know if they are going to play on them like they did with Cassandra's hair issue (Cass doesn't like getting her hair wet, however, BB made her participate in water games).
- Day 44 - The clip of Karen speaking to the house guests through audio, while in the studio is shown. The guests talked about how nice it was her husband was there to greet her and George thinks maybe things may change between them now. Brit is shown crying in Curtis' arms because she missed Karen. George, Cass and Jamie are shown in the kitchen talking about Karen. Cass said she believes anyone of them nominated for banishment against one of the 3 young guys is up the creek. George in the Red Room told BB that every time someone leaves the house there is an empty

spot. He said it is awkward and hard to get used to. He can't imagine what it will be like with only 3 left, and misses Karen because she had such a presence in the house. He wished her the best of luck.

- Jamie and Brit discuss Jamie nominating Karen for banishment. Jamie said it was very hard for her not to say anything during the week, but felt she did the right thing because Karen missed her family so deeply. Brit told Jamie she did the right thing not saying anything to Karen. Next, Jamie told Cass the exact same thing she told Brit. She said that it would have been in her best interest not to nominate Karen, because she doesn't think Karen would have nominated her, however, still believes she did the right thing. Directly after that conversation, Jamie is shown telling Eddie the exact same thing again. She asked him what she should do, and he immediately responded "get naked"... He told her to keep her chin up and that Karen forgives her.
- Jamie and Josh talked in the living room, and Josh told her that the past week in the house has been the most comfortable for him, even though he was nominated for banishment. Jamie told him she was watching him when Julie said his name Wednesday night, and he looked really surprised. Josh said his only regret would be to leave the house and not be who he is. He mentioned God, and Jamie said she believes God looks at the heart.
- The show ends with a clip of Josh, Jamie and Brit's earlier conversation in the bedroom, and Brit asking for a hug from Josh. Josh hugs her for a long time, then heads to the door, giving her a very sweet, long smile as he leaves the bedroom.

Day 45 (Friday, August 18, 2000) CBS Show

- The show begins with Brittany cleaning the kitchen cupboards and making bread at 6:00 a.m. She then cleans up the chicken poop, continues her cleaning, and heads to the Red Room. She told BB that it's nice to be up when everyone is sleeping and Karen would have liked it. Later that morning, Brit told Jamie that she was called into the Red Room and asked by BB how she felt about Jamie nominating Karen. Brit told Jamie that the "nice" lady is in there today, so Jamie immediately went in. Unfortunately, it was a man in there, and Jamie was disappointed, asking for Christine.
- Jamie and Curtis talked about the TV shows and Jamie said she thinks tonight's show will be a reaction show, reacting to Karen's departure. Jamie was concerned about how she'll be portrayed. Curtis told her not to worry and that she has no control over what BB does, only what she does. Later that day, Brit played with Chiquita on the kitchen floor. The pug chewed on her hair, managed to get her hair tie out of her pony tail, and ran away with it in her mouth. Curtis and Brit chased Chiquita through the bedroom and back to retrieve it.
- Eddie yelled at BB to give them something to do and that it's f***ing boring in there. He then pretended to play guitar, and began to shoot elastic bands at Jamie across the room. Jamie shot them back and hit Eddie in the eye. He wasn't hurt but Jamie felt bad. Eddie was then shown in the Red Room telling BB that they have made it halfway through the 3 month stay, and every second that goes by is a second closer to leaving and seeing his family and girlfriend. He said BB has no idea how nice it is for them to step outside on the front steps for 3 minutes every 2 weeks. The sun and the air is different out there.
- Eddie and Jamie were laying in separate beds in the boys room, and Brit came in to join them. Eddie told her to go away. Brit responded that if she left, Eddie would cry. Eddie told her he is over her. Eddie then lets out an enormous burp and blames Jamie for it. Eddie and Brit then playfully argue back and forth, and Eddie mimics Brit after everything she said, driving her so crazy she left. Eddie laughed his head off.
- The group were given a daily challenge - to be brutally honest with each other. One by one, they took a seat in a chair and the others circled around them taking turns saying what they hated about each other. It was pretty tame, except when Eddie told Brit he hates her green hair, nail polish and nose ring, and then told Jamie she wears too much make-up. Brit told Josh that she hates when he smiles and doesn't mean it. Curtis told Jamie he hates that she is self conscious around the pool, but has a great body. Both George and Brit told Jamie they hate that she doesn't always say what she means, or what's in her head. They then had to do the same thing but say what they like about

each other. Brit told Cass she likes her style and the way she accepts them and the love bed in the house. Eddie told Jamie he likes when she tans thinking no one is watching her, and he told George he likes how much he loves his family. Eddie told Brit he likes her big eyes, green lipstick, and Josh told her he likes that she wears the same undies as him. Then he mentioned something about women's panties, and the house broke out in laughter.

Day 46 (Saturday, August 19, 2000)

- No show was aired on CBS tonight due to a football game.

Day 48 (Monday, August 21, 2000) CBS Show

- A special one hour episode was shown tonight beginning with Day 45. Brittany and Eddie are shown in the bedroom discussing breaking the seal (masturbating). Eddie told her he goes into the bedroom in the afternoon when he won't get caught. When Brit asked him about the cameras, Eddie told her he doesn't care about them because BB won't show that on TV. Brit admitted she's really been thinking about it lately because she is studying for the Interstate Challenge, and when she studies at home, breaking the seal is her break-time. Jamie joined the conversation and asked Brit if she had done it, and pointed out Brit's rosy glow. Josh and Curtis joined in, teasing Brit. Josh asked if she's sure it's the studying and not Eddie that's making her think of it. Brit asked them if she broke the seal, would they? She told them that virgins have to masturbate regularly, she can't focus and that there are toxins in her body that need to be released.
- George and Cass were outside in the yard talking about how stressful the house can be at times. George said he doesn't know if it's the confinement of the house that adds to the feeling of a compound. Cass noted that there is no place to go to be quiet and be alone. Both agreed they will look at the world differently once they leave the house, and will appreciate their freedom.
- The Interstate Challenge was shown with each house guest being given two cities, and asked to state the Interstate highways you would need to take to get from one to the other. While each guest took their turn, BB showed a map of the two cities, and played sound effects of a car driving while the guest spoke. All house guests gave the right answer with George being saved for last. He took longer than the others to provide the answer, and when he finally did, and got it right, he collapsed to the floor with relief. The house guests were advised they were successful on the challenge and have won 20% of their grocery money. George was extremely happy about the success and was shown in the Red Room telling BB how he has always thought about going back to school to finish his degree, and that he has learned from the challenge he can compete with younger people. He now has a new outlook on finishing his education and feels confident he can do extremely well. He said "today has been a very good day".
- The house guests were given a daily challenge - to paint each other as animals. George was a cow, Josh a dinosaur, Curtis a tiger, Eddie a Chiquita, Brit a giraffe, Jamie a zebra and Cass a leopard. Once they were finished, they walked around the yard pretending to be the animals they were painted. Eddie did not participate in this part. Chiquita sat by the door to go inside. Later, Cass was shown in the Red Room telling BB that the atmosphere in the house is great and all are destressing and enjoying each other. Brit was shown upside down on the couch, stretching her back and her legs.
- Day 47 - Brit and Jamie discussed the next nominations in the bedroom. Jamie was trying to get Brit to remember a conversation the two of them had with Karen about the next nominations. When Brit couldn't recall the conversation, Jamie pointed out words in a book, hidden from the camera's view. Later, Jamie was asked in the Red Room what words she was pointing to. Jamie asked if she had to answer the question, and BB told her they are asking her to. After a long pause, Jamie asked again if she didn't answer, was that breaking house rules. BB replied "yes". Jamie then told BB that her and Brit were discussing the upcoming nominations, and she pointed to the words "two" and "men" in the book. She then said that they haven't told each other who they will be nominating.

- The house guests were given another daily challenge - to wrestle each other in sumo-wrestling outfits, two at a time. The grand winner would receive a special prize. Eddie and George went first with Eddie winning. Next, Jamie wrestled with Josh, with Josh winning. Brit and Curtis were next with Curtis winning. Round 2 began with Eddie wrestling Josh, and Eddie winning. Next were Cass against Curtis, with Curtis winning. The final round was Eddie against Curtis, and Eddie finished the big winner. The special prize was identified as a massage in the Red Room. Eddie was asked to wear a blindfold and was escorted by Curtis into the Red Room, and asked to lay face down on the massage table, with the blindfold still on. Once Curtis left the room, the masseuse entered but was unidentified to the viewers. Eddie speculated to BB that the masseuse would be a supermodel. As soon as the masseuse began, it was clear to Eddie that it was a male and after a lot of jumping around, grunting and banging on Eddie's back, Eddie began calling the person Bozo the Clown, and accusing them of not knowing what they were doing, being a dominatrix, and yelling "you suck!" The others sat in the living room, listening to Eddie yelling, and the banging from the jumping, and looked at each other in utter confusion. Curtis kept saying "I think he's yelling at the masseuse; I think he's fighting with the masseuse". BB asked the masseuse to please give a nice massage, and the face of the person was finally shown, identifying Will (Mega) - the first person to be banished from the house. Mega slipped out of the Red Room, unseen, and Eddie joined the others in the living room and told them what had happened. They all began speculating on who it could have been and agreed that it was someone famous, and possibly David Letterman, or Robin Williams. Eddie said that when he finds out who it was, he's going to kick their **s!
- Later that evening, the house guests were still talking about the mystery masseuse, and Curtis guessed that it was Will, since Will is a masseuse. Eddie disagreed, saying that Will would not come back to the house and is through with BB and CBS. The house guests discussed the Red Room around the kitchen table, and Brit admitted to lying sometimes when asked questions by BB. She said that sometimes she doesn't feel like answering the questions, and she will answer with what she wants to happen, or how she wants to feel, rather than reality. George was then shown in the Red Room telling BB that if Brit lies to BB, maybe she lies to the house guests. If you can't tell the truth, don't say anything.
- Day 48 - BB gave the guests their 7th challenge - a dance marathon. They were told that they must dance, two at a time, non-stop, 24-hours a day beginning at 3:00 p.m. today (Monday), until noon on Friday. The two must be touching at all times, and will be provided music through earphones. The switch of dancers must be executed with a tap on the shoulder and an immediate exchange of partners. If the dancing stops, the challenge is lost. BB supplied a disco ball, and asked the guests how much they wanted to wager of their weekly grocery allowance. Jamie said she wanted to wager 50%, but after some discussion, the group agreed on 20%. The show ended with Cass and Josh beginning to dance, with Josh complaining that the music was elevator music.

Day 49 (Tuesday, August 22, 2000) CBS Show

- The show begins with day 48 and Curtis and Cassandra dancing hand in hand for the weekly challenge. They were discussing the guys not dancing together. Curtis said that it's okay that the girls dance together, however, it gives him the "willies" to think about dancing with the guys. He then said that dancing with George would be okay because George is a dad figure, but dancing with Eddie or Josh would be weird. The others discussed the shifts for the dance challenge, and again discussed the boys dancing together. George was shown in the Red Room telling BB that the challenge is a good one but harder on the women as there are fewer of them. He said that the boys will dance together, but will have to do it in a way that doesn't look like they like each other in that way. He said that Josh is protective of how he looks to the public, and Eddie is a real team player because he is willing to dance with the guys to give the girls a break.
- Josh and Brit were in the living room talking, with George dancing alone in the kitchen. Josh said the challenge would be more entertaining if Jordan was still in the house.

George blurted out "yeah, we could stick a pole out there". He looked surprised he had said that out loud, and all laughed really hard.

- Day 49 - 8:17 a.m. - Curtis and Cassandra were dancing in the yard with all the other house guests asleep. BB's voice boomed over the loud speaker that it was "all dance" time and for all guests to assemble outside within 30 seconds. Josh and Brit jumped out of the love bed along with Jamie, George and Eddie, and all ran outside. The seven then half slept, half rocked in a circle, for one song. Brit looked like she was still asleep. It was very funny! After, the five went back to bed.
- Cassandra and Jamie discussed how they should all support each other, no matter what BB throws at them, and be proud of what they've accomplished, no matter when they leave the house. Jamie confessed to Cass that she felt like she never fit in at high school because she didn't know how to be in a group, but feels that she is learning that in the house. She said that it is very challenging for her, and knows that everything they do or say is in the public eye. They both said they understand why people would never agree to be in the BB house. The next scene, Josh and Curtis dance together, hand in hand, while BB plays love music in the background. Next, George and Curtis take a turn, followed by Eddie and George. Curtis is shown in the Red Room talking to BB about the nominations. He said that it's not about who he likes/dislikes in the house, rather who he spends the least amount of time with. He said that if he had to pick two people today, it would be George and Eddie because they are the two he hangs out with the least.
- BB gives the house guests a daily challenge - to match a quote with the person who said it. Jamie read one that said "who said I'd do a guy before kissing him"? After a lot of laughing, Josh put up his hand. Everyone laughed really hard, while Josh tried to explain why he said it. He said you could close your eyes and pretend it was a girl, but kissing is more intimate. George teased and teased Josh for quite a while after, as the game continued. The last quote was "who wore a tiara on national TV?". Jamie then had to tell George about being the current Ms. Washington - he was the last to find out. After the game, the others, but mainly George all teased Josh about what he had said, to the point where Josh walked away, not looking too happy. Brit and Josh went to the boys room and climbed into bed together to cuddle.
- The show ended with all the guests dancing together outside, and Eddie looked to be enjoying himself. BB will not be shown on Wednesday night, due to the season finale of Survivor, however, a one-hour live episode will be shown on Thursday night.

Day 50 (Wednesday, August 23, 2000)

- No show due to the season finale of Survivor.

Day 51 (Thursday, August 24, 2000) CBS Live Nomination Show 4

- The show began with Josh and Cassandra dancing together in the living room. Cass held up a sign that said "happy birthday Mom" and sent her Mom a message. Julie Chen addressed the guys concerns over dancing together for the challenge. She then acknowledged that Jamie had won Tuesday's daily challenge, who knows the housemates the best, and it was time to receive her prize. Julie told Jamie that two people are waiting for her in the Red Room - a Hollywood Casting Director who has been nominated for an Emmy Award, and Jamie's Mom. Jamie was advised she can only choose one person to speak to. After some debating back and forth, Jamie chose Anthony, the Casting Director. She was then given 2 minutes only to speak with Anthony. Jamie immediately went into the Red Room and hugged Anthony. Anthony asked her a series of questions like does she like comedy or drama, does she have any experience, is she ready to move to California and take classes, who is her favourite actor, etc. Jamie answered all the questions, telling him she admires Meryl Streep, and has had experience in Baywatch and being Miss Washington. She told him she is ready to do this. His advice to her was to move to Hollywood, sign up for some classes and get committed. Their conversation was cut off when the 2 minutes expired.
- Jamie joined the others and told them what had happened. Julie advised the audience that the halfway point of the guests' stay in the house has passed, and how the nomination process causes tension for the house guests. Clips were then shown of

previous nominations, including how Jordan reacted the first time she was nominated, the first time the house guests were told how many nominations they had each received, Eddie's speech to all of them regarding not asking who nominated them, and their refusal to watch the live Red Room nominations. Julie said that the house guests have become concerned, angry and almost paranoid about the nominations.

- The Fig Garden Village was aired, with family and friends of Josh gathered for a party in his honor. Friends, Aunt Susie and Josh's step-father were all interviewed one by one, all routing for Josh. Julie interviewed Dr. Drew Pinsky, who felt that trust has really been an issue for the house guests, and letting them know how many nominations they each received adds to that issue. He believes some are getting paranoid, noting George wagging his finger at the cameras. Dr. Pinsky also said that he believes Jamie has come clean about her reason for being in the house (to become famous) and the guilt she will feel for passing up her mother to meet with the Casting Director is something she will have to deal with.
- During this time, each house guest was shown giving their two nominations for banishment to BB in the Red Room. After each viewing, the house guests were updated on how many nominations they had each received. BB then went to Winnebago, Illinois to George's old high school, where past high school friends and teachers wished George the best in the BB house. Julie then brought up Brittany's hair styling techniques and we were treated to clips of Brit's different hair colors (green, pink, blonde) and the different wigs she has worn while in the house. Also shown was Brit's styling and dying of Josh, Curtis and George's hair.
- Regina Lewis from America Online was interviewed by Julie, and said that Brit's hairstyles are always a topic of conversation online. A survey was conducted on AOL during the past week, asking the public to identify their favorite house guest. The guests were then advised of this poll, and each were told the results. Brit was the most liked, receiving 33% of the votes. Next came George with 17% of the votes, followed by Cassandra with 12%. A three way tie between Eddie, Jamie and Josh came next each receiving 10%, and Curtis came in last with 8%. Everyone congratulated Brit, and Jamie pointed out their earlier conversation that day, and that the news could not have come at a better time for Brit.
- An LA restaurant was shown, where the waiters/waitresses dressed and acted like the BB house guests. It was very funny. The house guests were then advised that the TV had been assembled in the living room for them all to watch a video. Julie advised them that they will not be forced to watch, and George almost stood up, thinking it was the live nominations. Julie quickly notified them that it is actually Eddie's massage and the identity of the masseuse will be revealed. All of the house guests watched the massage, including Eddie's profanity and name-calling, then saw that the masseuse was Will (Mega). They all thought it was pretty funny, and Eddie said that he will indeed still smack Will around the next time they come face to face.
- The final house guest (Brit) was then shown giving her two nominations, and the house guests were advised of the results. They were: George (3); Josh (2); Cass (2); Curtis (2); Brit (2); Eddie (2); Jamie (1). Since there was a 5 way tie for second place, the 5 plus George are all nominated for banishment next Wednesday, and all will need to pack their bags for the next live show. George reacted very positively towards the news, even though these were his first votes ever, and Jamie complained that she also should be up for banishment. They told her she shouldn't complain. George said he's happy and glad to be in the boat with the rest of them. The show ended with the guests playing with Chiquita, and Jamie talking about how she thinks the show is very big since AOL has their own site on it.
- To nominate 1 of the 6 house guests for banishment, call 1(900) 740-1000 U.S. or 1(900) 870-9846 (Canada).

Day 52 (Friday, August 25, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Jamie talking to George on Day 50, about the prize that she will receive for winning the daily challenge. They speculated on what it could be, and Jamie suggested that perhaps she will be blindfolded and escorted into the studio to host Thursday's live show with Julie Chen. George thought that perhaps she will receive

a newspaper and she can read it and tell the others what's going on in the world. After, George was shown sneaking around, grabbing things from the kitchen. He then sat down and began gluing pretzels and coffee beans to a piece of cardboard. He spelt out the words "Save George".

- Curtis was shown in the Red Room talking to BB about Josh. He said that Josh is savvy, takes care of himself and knows what he is doing, but also sometimes seems innocent. He said he gets confused by Josh because of the conflicting messages he sends. Josh told Curtis that he and Jamie are having a secret relationship, but Curtis thinks either Josh is confused or a liar. He also said that Josh is a player with women, however has a conscience also. He can't figure him out.
- Day 51 - George was shown in the Red Room talking to BB about the nominations. BB asked him if he would do naked trampoline after the votes are in. George laughed really hard and took an extraordinarily long time saying there was no way he would do naked trampoline. Later, all 7 guests are in the bedroom, discussing whether they would do naked trampoline if they would be given \$500,000.00. Brit immediately said she would do it, and Eddie piped up saying he would do it for \$20.00. George said he would have to call home to see if it's okay if he did it, but knows his family would say yes. Suddenly, the music blared over the loudsystem, signaling "all dance" time, and all guests immediately got up and started dancing crazy. George turned the lights out for a second then back on.
- As each guest took their turn going into the Red Room to give their two nominations, they told each other how BB interrogated them. Eddie said it was like 20 questions, and no answer he could give was good enough. Jamie said she made a comment about Hitler that really made BB angry. Brit said they were very easy on her, but Cass said she was insulted by the questions she was asked, mentioning that they had asked her if she had a strategic advantage nominating the ones she did. Jamie receiving her prize was repeated on TV during the live show last night, and after the show, Jamie talked to Brit about choosing the Casting Director over her mother. All the guests agreed she did the right thing and will see her mom soon. Eddie said that Brit has a glow about her, like she got laid, but really it was from being the most popular on the AOL poll.
- George was shown sneaking around again, and we caught a glimpse of a sign reading "Save our Hero". George sneaked a bottle of ketchup into the boys bedroom, took out one of his shirts and poured 3 drops of ketchup on his shirt in a straight line across the chest. He then placed the shirt in the BB suitcase. George and Eddie took a turn in the dance competition and plea to the public not to vote them out. They both say hello to Theresa, George's wife and talk to the beer drinkers of America. Later, George is shown in the Red Room wearing the shirt with the ketchup marks on it. He had glued band-aids over the ketchup marks, making it look like bloody wounds that had been covered up. He then pleaded with America to save him, saying he is wounded, has bad feet from dancing, and wants to stay in the house. He also said that the best of George will be shown during the next week, and he's pulling out his best ammunition now.
- The show finished with all of them dancing in the bedroom.

Day 53 (Saturday, August 26, 2000) CBS Show

- The week was reviewed briefly with an extra focus on the house guests teasing Josh after his comment about doing a guy before kissing him. Five guests talked over dinner about the comment, and George continued his teasing. Also, Brit and Josh were shown outside dancing, and Brit asked Josh if he had ever had his toes sucked. He said no, and she said neither had she. Cass joined them and seemed disgusted when Brit asked her about her toes. Later, the guests were wondering why the nominations had been delayed, and Eddie sang a song to Brittany with the words saying that the TV show sucked and that BB is finished. He then mooned Brit after she complained about his shorts being so low. Brit looked truly disgusted. George's pleading with the public in the Red Room was also shown again.
- Day 52 - Eddie was shown in the Red Room answering BB's question about who he thought may have nominated him for banishment. He said he thinks it was Jamie. Next, George said he thinks Brit nominated him; and Brit said she believes it was Cass and maybe Josh, then said "no - George". (All were right). Brit said she doesn't want to

leave the house and feels that it is her home now. She also said she is sad they are losing someone next week.

- The guests are shown complying with BB's request of one final all dance. They dress like cowboys and participate in a square dance. They win their dance challenge, and 20% more of the grocery money. Later, Eddie is shown on one knee asking Brit to marry him. He gives her a twist tie ring and she proudly displays it to Jamie. Jamie then said that she had asked Ed to marry her, and is now only his mistress. The house guests, in the bedroom, told each other what they are physically attracted to about each other. Josh said he likes Jamie's eyes, Brit's nose and Cass's skin. Cass said she likes Curtis' eyebrows, George's midsection and Josh's upper body. Jamie said she likes Brit's teeth and Eddie's eyelashes. Brit said she likes George's smile when he's embarrassed and Josh's small smile.
- All the house guests are asked by BB to assemble in the dining room. They were then given their daily challenge of a relay style race. A baby doll was provided as the baton, and the guests were told they must crawl on their stomachs in mud through a maze, keeping the baby completely mud free to win the challenge. The guests then had to go into the yard, dump dirt all over the grass, and hose it down until it became muddy. They then had to assemble the relay track with sticks and pink ribbons. Each guest took their turn, crawling on their stomachs, holding the baby doll up to keep her clean. They were all successful. They ended the game with a mud fight, with all participating with the exception of Cassandra. Eddie, after muddying up the baby doll, flung her over the compound wall.
- Cass was shown in the Red Room talking to BB about her hair issues. She said she could not participate in the mud fight because getting mud in her hair would have ruined it forever. She also said she was not pleased with the square dance because it is not part of her culture, and she was not comfortable doing it. Later, Brit told Eddie in the yard that she thought it was weird that BB did not pick any super thin girls to be in the house. Eddie responded that Brit and Jamie weren't "heifers", and that he finds Brit more attractive than Jamie. Brit thanked him and kissed him on the forehead. She told him she thinks she's cute but not sexy. He said you have to feel sexy to be sexy. He said he thinks he is an average looking guy, and Brit immediately told him he is above average looking and must know it.
- That evening, Brit straddled Jamie on the bed and laid down on top of her. Josh, lying on the opposite bed just watched them, while Curtis joined them on the third bed. Brit explained to them all that that is how she used to sleep on her ex-boyfriend. She then showed Curtis, and next Josh what it felt like. The show ended with them all laughing.

Day 55 (Monday, August 28, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 53 - Brittany asked Jamie to tell her what pageants are like. Jamie explained to her the many steps you must partake while in a contest. She said that while she was in Miss USA, it took three weeks. Brit confessed that her view on pageants was pretty negative, and doesn't know how someone can judge you when they don't even know who you are. Josh said he thinks the cool people always win. Jamie explained that if you do win, you give 250 speeches per year, are moved to New York to live in a penthouse and are paid a salary for your year's work.
- Day 54 - Jamie acts as the MC for the BB beauty pageant. Two house guests were to be crowned Mr. and Miss BB 2000. The pageant began with the talent show. Cass read a poem she wrote herself, George cooked butt bread, Jamie did gymnastics, Curtis did some strange dance, and Eddie juggled three eggs standing on one leg. Next came the swimsuit contest, with Josh doing a Chippendales dance, and Jamie strutting with her bikini on but a shirt on top of it. The final round was the Platform round, where all the guests spoke very seriously about world issues such as immigration, disability and world peace. Eddie won Mr. BB 2000 and Cass and Brit tied for Miss BB 2000. The three were treated to a private dinner for just them outside in the yard with the menu of their choice. Brit chose lobster and caesar salad. Cass chose beef and pork ribs, and Eddie chose surf and turf. The others moped around in the bedroom telling each other what they would have ordered had they won the contest.

- Brit confessed to Jamie in bed that being nominated for banishment by two people really bothered her, and that she is scared to leave the house. Cass joined them, and Brit told her how she was feeling. Cass immediately told Brit that nominations are just part of being in the house and that she shouldn't think that two people don't like her because she was nominated. She told her to get her head on straight and not take it personally.
- The house guests were given their weekly challenge - a 4,928 piece jigsaw puzzle. They agreed to wager 50% of their weekly grocery allowance this week.
- Day 55 - George took Chiquita outside to the yard, and suddenly called for Brittany. Brit and the others ran outside to see a plane flying by trailing a sign that read "Vote George - Save Brit". Brit thought the sign was mean and hugged George while she cried. Curtis said it was probably Karen flying the plane. Later, Brit asked the guys if George was okay about the plane incident. George was shown in the Red Room trying another attempt to the public for support. He was wearing a scarf on his head, speaking in an Arabic accent, and saying how he owns a convenience store, that George is his best customer, and we must vote to keep George in the house. Brit is shown trying to get Chiquita to do #2 outside, however, she wouldn't go. The show ends with the house guests balancing books on their head during the pageant.

Day 56 (Tuesday, August 29, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Josh and Brit in bed alone in the dark. They were hugging each other and it looked like they were about to kiss. Brit suddenly got up and pulled Josh up too. They both went outside in the yard and talked about how they feel about each other. Brit told Josh she really wants to kiss him, but doesn't want it to happen because they are both locked up in the house. Josh said he likes her too much to kiss her and doesn't want things to change between them. He said they should each go to their separate rooms, but she said she doesn't want that either. Later, Brit dyes her hair once again, but this time it's black.
- Eddie was shown in the Red Room talking to BB about Jamie. He said that Jamie did the right thing picking the Casting Director to talk to over her mother, however, his Mom would kick his *ss if he picked someone over her.
- Day 56 - The house guests are each given a questionnaire that they are asked to complete on their own in separate parts of the house within 15 minutes. Jamie complained to Eddie about the questions and said she can't believe BB is asking them to do this. She said it is stupid and will only hurt peoples feelings. Cass said she refused to put names down against the questions, reading some of the questions as saying "who is the most two faced? the weakest?". Jamie said it is not productive and she'll throw hers in the barbecue. Eddie said you won't be able to tell who wrote what, and it doesn't bother him. Cassandra was shown in the Red Room complaining to BB that she's had enough, is not doing the questionnaire and is ready to leave the house. She felt that the game was mean spirited and she doesn't want to hurt anyones feelings. BB explained to her that the point of BB is honesty and to challenge each other. He said that the goal is to have the house guests bring honest emotions to the table. We were then shown a clip of August 27 when the guests were all talking about race and Eddie said he doesn't feel that race is a major problem in the U.S. anymore. BB asked Cass about that, and Cass explained that she is not going to push discussions about race and being the only black person in the house, does not want to become the center of attention this week especially. A clip of August 23 was then shown, with Cass complaining about BB interrogating her about nominations and strategies. BB then asked Cass about that comment and said she does indeed have a strategy. Cass responded that she is just trying to survive in the house and keep a positive image. She said she will take a leap of faith and stay in the house this time, but knows she will be disappointed next time BB does something bad.
- Cass explained to the others what BB and her discussed in the Red Room and said that the questionnaire was not meant to hurt them, but instead, to promote deeper interaction. BB feels that they are superficial and want to force them to be more real. They are too happy go lucky, and are copping out on their real feelings about the BB experience and how they feel about each other. Brit said she doesn't think she can be

anymore real than she is right then. The house guests finally completed the questionnaire and were split into two teams with Brit asking the questions. Each team were asked questions on the others and the following was determined: Most brave - Josh, Cass & Ed; neatest - Josh; sloppiest - Ed; longest in bathroom - Cass; most attractive - Jamie; most loyal - Jamie; most two faced - Jamie; least amount of chores - Ed, Brit & Jamie; most likely to be banished this week - Curtis.

- Eddie was shown in the Red Room talking to BB about the game and saying that people are foolish if they don't complete tasks asked of them by BB. Their job as contestants is to comply with the rules. He said that all the guests complained about the questions, yet laughed at all the questions once playing the game. He said this is not going to be the worse thing that will happen while in the BB house. George was then shown in the Red Room dressed in a red wig, his big shirt with fake breasts. I believe he was trying to be Karen, and was pretending to smoke a cigarette. He spoke in a fake-woman's voice and said that George was responsible for the large breasts because of the pure hose water he had given her. He then said that he/she doesn't understand why George was nominated out of BB because of the wonderful breast enhancements he had created (very strange)....

Day 57 (Wednesday, August 30, 2000) CBS Live Banishment Show 4

- Julie Chen opened the live show talking about Jamie's choice last week in picking the Casting Director over her mother. She then showed the clip of Jamie talking to George about hosting the live show with Julie one day. Julie addressed the group about how they feel about six of them being up for banishment. They all said they are doing well. Julie then told Jamie that since she is the only one not marked, she gets a surprise.... Julie offered her the opportunity to host the show with her tonight. Her responsibilities would be to interview one of the house guests, introduce a video, and announce the banished house guest. Jamie was given 10 seconds to think about the offer. Of course Jamie agreed to do it, and was asked to go into the Red Room and open the envelope holding the banished guest's name. Jamie immediately left the living room, opened the envelope and looked shocked by the name she read. Julie reminded her that it is important to demonstrate poise and to not give away the name at this time.
- Jamie joined the others in the living room, and chose George to be the guest to interview for 1 minute. She asked him how he feels about being marked, and he went on and on about it being okay. Jamie interrupted him, asking about the infomercials he has been doing, and how his products will be available to the public shortly. Right away, George said "shortly?" thinking possibly he is the guest to be banished. Jamie quickly covered herself saying "some time in the next 30 days". Julie interviewed Jamie's friends and mother regarding the choice made last week to spend 2 minutes with the Casting Director. Most said they couldn't believe she didn't pick her mom. A Seattle radio station did a phone in poll regarding the choice, and the responses were mixed.
- Julie told the public about a campaign that had been held in Rockford, Illinois by George's wife Theresa. A bar had been turned into a phone in call center and everyone was phoning to vote out Brit. Corporate sponsors were supporting the campaign and paying for the cost of phoning in. Theresa said they chose Brit to vote out because she is George's biggest competition. Julie then interviewed Brit's mother who was very surprised George's family would target Brit. She said it was okay to set up a campaign, but they shouldn't be targetting one person. Julie then interviewed Dr. Pinsky who said that George has become desperate to stay this past week, and has shown poor judgement. He said his actions were goofy and unsettling. He also said that the campaign is not good, as they are going after someone George has become very close too.
- Julie then interviewed the AOL Spokeswoman, who said that 100,000 posts have been posted on the board this past week, and George and Brit have the most votes. She said that traffic was very heavy when the plane flew overhead, and when Jamie chose the Casting Director. Jamie, as co-host, introduced the video segment of Chiquita, the only guest who will not be banished. Clips of the dog were then played. Finally, Julie told Jamie she must now announce the guest to be banished. Jamie composed herself,

stood tall and announced to the guests that the person to be banished from the house this week is Brittany. Brit looked stunned, and didn't move for a second. She then stood and hugged each one of them, with Josh giving her an extra long hug. He looked like he was going to cry. They walked her to the door, and she hugged them all again, with Josh kissing her on the face twice. Brit grabbed her bags and headed out the door, but this time, the guests had to stay inside...I guess they're no longer allowed out on the steps.

- The house guests were shown in the yard, with Eddie comforting Jamie and George comforting Josh. Josh sat alone with his head down and told George he thought Brit would be the last one left. He said he hates this. Brit's mother met her at the gate and immediately told her about George's family's campaign to vote her out of the house. Brit joined Julie in the studio, with a huge round of applause, and people wearing green and blue wigs. Brit told her she felt really weird that all these people are there cheering her on and she's just a nobody. Julie asked her if she was surprised to be banished after last week's popularity vote. Brit said no, because if you are well liked, you can be equally disliked. Julie showed her clips of her time in the house, while Brit laughed and said she feels like a "dork". Brit was then shown clips of her on and off relationship with Josh, and the confrontations, and snuggling. Brit hid her face and said she is "so pathetic". Brit explained to Julie that life in the house is not like real life. That every little thing is magnified in the house, and you don't have work, family, hobbies to keep you entertained, so you focus your feelings on all the little things in the house. A kiss with Josh would have exploded into something too big, and Brit was not ready for that. She said she has true feelings for Josh, and believes he likes her too. She said they will be friends after the show, but she would put her friendship with Jamie before Josh, because "guys come and go".
- Julie showed Brit a cartoon that had been created of her on the Internet. She then asked her about her virginity and said she is the most famous virgin now. Brit explained why she was so open about that side of her and that it is just a part of her. She said she started the lovebed because it was very lonely and empty in the house for her, and she needed the affection to get close to people and open up more. She said she won't go back to pharmaceutical sales, but would like to get into entertainment. When asked who she believes will win the money, she had no idea. Brit was given a final opportunity to say goodbye to the guests, and did so live. All of them looked sad and uncomfortable as the show ended. BB will not be on TV Thursday night.

Day 58 (Tuesday, August 31, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 56 - Eddie and Cassandra discuss strategies in the house. Ed told Cass that friendships formed in the house are worth more than the prize money of \$500,000.00. He said he loves Brittany, but she is his biggest threat to win the money. He also said he knows Cass needs the money to take care of her Mom, so he wouldn't nominate her until the very end. Cass said you can never tell what the public will want or do in the end. Ed said it's getting harder to nominate people and play the game. Brit and Jamie discussed the moment of truth game they played the day before. Jamie said she believes she received the most loyal and most two-faced votes because she nominated Karen for banishment. Brit said she was not hurt by her votes of most insecure, most wishy-washy and most lazy. She knows she is not any of those things. The group participated in a football game, with all playing except Cassandra.
- Jamie and Cassandra talked about stereotypes in the house, and Cass said Jamie is not your average beauty queen...She's smart and deep. Jamie said Cass helps white America see black America in another way. She said that Cass demonstrates great character and is a very good example. Later, Cassandra talked to BB in the Red Room about how Jamie wants to learn about things and didn't really think about issues before coming into the house. She doesn't let Jamie inside her head because she doesn't want her to worry...
- Day 57 - Brit and Josh share a private moment before the live show, holding hands in the bedroom. Josh said it feels like they just arrived in the house, and Brit said it feels like they've been in there forever. Brit told Josh she's really glad she met him, and Josh replied that she is just what he needed, a very pleasant surprise. Brit told him it's a

good thing they didn't kiss, and that she hopes to stay friends after the house. She also told him to ensure in his next relationship, he only stay with that person if he's really happy. George told Eddie that he has never played sports or been in competitions before the house, and that he thinks it's really cool. Ed responded that it is cool to see how it will turn out, and that he himself is very competitive. George said it's like waiting for the opening kick-off.

- After Brit exits the BB house, Josh immediately walked away from the others, obviously wanting to be alone. He went out to the yard but the others followed. Ed started yelling Brit's name at the top of his lungs, yelling "we love you Brit". They all followed suit yelling as loud as they could, hoping she could hear them. Josh looked very sad, walking around alone. George, and then Cass tried to comfort him. Jamie later talked to George about how she felt when she opened the envelope holding Brit's name at the beginning of the live show. She said she didn't want to look at anyone, her hands were shaking, and she almost cried. She said she was really acting, not just co-hosting the show. George told her she did a good job. Both said how shocked they were that Brit was voted out, and both thought she'd be the last one left in the house. Eddie said hello to his bed, and talked to it about how they are stuck with each other for at least 2 more weeks and they will have to make the most of it...he must have been bored.
- Later that evening, the group discussed what they liked most about Brit. Ed said he has nothing but good to say about Brit. Curtis said that all Brit's stories were hilarious, and his favorite times with her were out by the pool because that is where she talked about her fears and he got to see the real Brit. Cass said Brit told her she felt she could learn from Cass, and Brit always wanted to lead her own life. George said he liked it when Brit stood up to Will in the early days of the house, and when Brit dyed his hair blue. Jamie said she was happy they had become such good friends, and Brit is so intelligent and accomplished and so very funny. Josh said he realized how much he liked Brit when she stood up to Will. He couldn't believe she would do that and she was so courageous. Eddie in the Red Room told BB that he is very sad that Brit has left, however, knows that everyone in the house feels some relief that they are still there.
- The show ended with Curtis in the Red Room talking about Brit, and crying a little over how sad he was that she had left. He said she was the first person to be voted out that he had become close to. He was very surprised by the vote, and felt that Brit was important to the house.

Day 59 (Friday, September 1, 2000) CBS Show

- Day 58 - Josh in the Red Room talked about Brit being gone and the internal change that will now happen in the house. He said they will all have to bond together and will inevitably become closer. He wishes Brit the best. Cassandra and Curtis also discussed Brit's absence. Curtis said he is still trying to get over how sad he felt about Brit leaving. Cass said he was very close to Brit and also believed that he would be the one voted out. Curtis said he wants to stay, and win, however has not become competitive mentally. He said that BB is not a game, but really a popularity contest and there is no way to gage that. Cass said it was different when Karen left the house because she wanted to be banished, but Brit always said how badly she wanted to stay.
- George and Eddie discussed the prize money, while in the bedroom, and Eddie suggested that BB bring three suitcases into the house with the money inside. He said that would change the dynamics of the house for sure. George said that would be funny as there is no place to spend the money, and Ed responded that they could wipe their *ss with it. Ed said that this is a contest, not a love fest and that it would be funny to watch how everyone reacted to seeing the prize money. He said that Curtis wouldn't be able to breathe.
- Eddie and Josh discussed the upcoming days left in the house, and how the time will go fast now. Josh said he didn't come into the house to win the money, but rather he spends so much time alone, that he wanted his friends and family to see who he really is. Ed said your best friends are the ones who see everything and still like you. Later, making dinner, Cass was peeling a zucchini and the others made reference to it being sexual. They all had a good laugh, including Cass. After dinner, the group discussed

whether they would rather be rich now, and poor later, or vice versa. Each said what they would prefer and why.

- BB announced to the house guests their daily challenge. Each had to give five reasons why they deserve to win the prize money. They were given 10 minutes to think about their response, and then were called into the Red Room one at a time. It went like this:
 - Eddie
 1. His family is an average, hardworking family, however, can't seem to get ahead;
 2. Will be able to put his brother through college;
 3. Can relocate his family to a better area;
 4. Can provide financial assistance for his family;
 5. He wants to win more than anyone else in the house.
 - Josh
 1. Can pay for his nieces' education;
 2. Will prove that he won't abuse the money;
 3. Will be able to pay his \$20,000 student loan;
 4. Will show that with or without money, he can be happy;
 5. Comes from a humble family, and wants to make them proud.
 - George
 1. Can finish his education;
 2. Will be able to put his eldest daughter through college;
 3. Would be nice to not just get through life paycheck to paycheck;
 4. His kids are expecting him to win;
 5. Would be able to buy his mom a new car.
 - Cass
 1. Feels like she's been a positive force in the house;
 2. Has always been true to herself;
 3. Would be able to do things for her family;
 4. No woman in any other country's BB has ever won;
 5. The women are dropping like flies, and she can go head to head with the guys.
 - Jamie
 1. Left career and financial stability to come into the house;
 2. Could pay off her student loans;
 3. Came into the house for fun and with no strategy;
 4. If it's meant to be it will happen;
 5. Will be happy for anyone who wins the prize.
 - Curtis
 1. Lived a decent life;
 2. Has contributed to the chores and challenges in the house;
 3. If he wins, it means he made it for 3 months, and it was fun;
 4. Would be wonderful to win and he would stay an attorney and be able to provide community help to those who couldn't afford it;
 5. The person who is most deserving of the prize will win.
- The announcer told the viewers that during next Wednesday's live show, one of the house guests would be offered \$10,000.00 to leave the house right away. The house guests discussed how they used to all hang out in small groups, i.e. Eddie and George, but now they hang out together. George said he never felt comfortable butting in to the others conversations, but now he does. The show ended with the group playing water volleyball.

Day 60 (Saturday, September 2, 2000) CBS Show

- The first half hour of the show was a review of the past week, including the moment of truth game (questionnaire) and Cass telling BB she is ready to leave the show; the vote on Wednesday night with Brit leaving the show; and the house guests coping after Brit was banished.

- Day 59 - Eddie in the Red Room told BB that they have failed the weekly challenge of putting together the jigsaw puzzle. The guests had wagered 50% of their grocery money on the challenge and therefore lost \$100.00. Eddie said that they will all lose some weight next week now. He also said that they chose to dedicate their time to each other since one of them was going to be banished. He felt they did the right thing.
- Day 60 - Jamie told the others that there is a big parade this weekend in Seattle, and she, as Miss Washington, was supposed to be in it. She was worried about how her behavior in the house may affect her title, and is sure the runner up has been awarded the crown. She speculated with Curtis about her losing her title, and that BB felt sorry for her, and that's why she was asked to host the live show with Julie Chen. Later, Jamie dressed George up as a woman, including making him wear her bikini top, putting makeup on him, which included full eyeliner, lipstick, etc. and adding clips to his hair. She then paraded him around and they all laughed except Eddie. George woke Josh up who was sleeping on the couch, and again, they all laughed.
- Later that day, George and Cassandra discussed being in the house, and George admitted that he was having one of those days where he missed his family and was worried about what they thought of his antics in the house, including dressing up as a woman. Cass reassured him that his daughters would be proud of him because he's such a cool dad. They then discussed education and the fact that George's eldest daughter wasn't convinced she needed to go on to college after high school. George said he didn't realize how expensive schooling was, and Cass told him that when she went to university 20 years ago, it cost her \$20,000.00 per year. George said that he regrets not going to college after school and hopes that his daughters learn from his mistake. He told Cass that the house really makes you think about your life.
- Jamie and Josh discussed their fears, while alone by the pool. Josh said his biggest fear about leaving the house is spending too much time alone again. He said when he's at school, he has no time to spend with people, and he's really enjoyed being with so many people in the house. Jamie told him women will be knocking down his door after he leaves the house. She said her parents married when her mom was 17 and her dad was 19, but she wasn't born until her mom was 29. They then divorced when her mom was 34. Josh said his parents divorced when he was 3. Jamie said she's never been with a guy who she has felt she could spend the rest of her life with. Josh said he knows the right girl for him won't approach him, and he's too shy to approach girls, so he's not sure what he's going to do. He said he just wants a girl that understands him.
- The house guests participated in a game called true or false, whereby cards were read about each of the house guests, and the others had to guess whether the fact was true or false. A few of the facts were: While Curtis was in senior year of college, he peed in the living room while sleep-walking; George played in his opposing high school team's band; Cass' hair caught on fire while in university and Josh barely escaped a rampaging bull. Josh and Jamie won the game with 19 points each, and therefore won the prize which was a video postcard home to their families. The public was reminded once again that on Wednesday's live show, one of the guests would have the opportunity to leave the house with \$10,000.00.

Day 62 (Monday, September 4, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opened on Day 61 with George cutting out letters from what looked like sheet metal, and nailing the letters onto the backyard fence. When he was finished, he had spelt "happy anniversary Teresa 22". Curtis pointed out to him that he had spelt anniversary wrong. George fixed it and thanked Curtis for pointing it out. George then stared for a long time at the message and blew a kiss at it. The house guests were given their weekly challenge by BB. This week, they must train Chiquita to follow an obstacle course, without touching her. The guests went into the yard to look at the course, which included pylons for the dog to go in between, a tiny slide which she has to climb up, and go down, plus other things. The group agreed to wager 20%. Eddie told Chiquita she was a "fat *ss - you're fat and you know it".
- Josh and Curtis were throwing a football back and forth when Curtis realized that someone was throwing something over the compound wall into the backyard. George thought it was paint balls, but Curtis said it was jawbreakers and encouraged both Josh

and George inside the house. George instead grabbed one and ate it. Curtis, taking it very seriously, told George he shouldn't eat them and that they could be poisoned. George kept saying how tastey they were. Eddie yelled loudly "fire some beer over the wall", then also told George off for eating one. Jamie agreed that they were definitely candy. Curtis told George to pay attention to how he was feeling, in case it was poisoned. Later, Eddie was doing the dishes and yelling that he was doing "b*tch work" over and over again. He then started dancing while banging the pots and pans and told Cassandra that this one was for her. Both Jamie and Cass did not look impressed.

- Day 62 - BB asked the house guests, if given the chance, would they agree to split the first, second and third prize money six ways. The total would be \$650,000.00 divided by six leaves \$108,000.00 each. All agreed that they would certainly split the money, except Eddie. He said that they all knew what they were getting themselves into coming into the house, that there is no glory in splitting the money, and it gives him a reason to get up every day and participate in the day to day activities. He also said that it would not be fair to the banished house guests, especially Brit who only just left last week. Cass said it would be nice to split the money and enjoy the last 30 days as a group. Josh said \$108,000.00 is a lot of money. George said he would like to split the money and is sick of the whole money issue. Eddie said if they decided to split the money, he would walk out tonight without his \$108,000.00. Jamie then challenged him, saying that what he wants is the \$500,000 rather than them all getting a piece of the pie. He said he would like everyone to have some money, but wants to finish the game in the way that it was meant to be played.
- Later, when Eddie was not around, the group talked about their earlier conversation. Jamie said she is really competitive, however, would want to share the money. George agreed, saying they are like a family now. Cass said that Eddie protects himself by saying things like he had said earlier, and that he wants to be the winner. George told BB in the Red Room that he is worried about Eddie. He fears that the house guests are getting mad at Eddie and that he says things to the cameras that he shouldn't be saying. He hopes Ed doesn't hurt his chances with the public.
- Eddie appeared in the Red Room later, and told BB that the house guests did not like his response to splitting the prize money. He said he could have lied and said what they all wanted to hear, and suspects some of them did lie, however, wanted to be honest. He would like for all of them to have a share of the money, but in the contest of the game, they should go to the end. He repeated that it would not be fair to the banished house guests. The public was reminded once again that on Wednesday's live show, one of the guests would have the opportunity to leave the house with \$20,000.00, suddenly doubled from the original \$10,000.00 previously announced. The show ended with Josh trying to teach Chiquita how to go up and down the slide.

Day 63 (Tuesday, September 5, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opened on Day 63 with the house guests in the backyard. Suddenly they hear a woman's voice booming over a megaphone on the other side of the fence. She said to them "on Wednesday, Big Brother will offer you money to leave - don't take it". BB immediately ordered the guests inside the house, and continued to order them because they weren't listening. Finally, they gathered in the kitchen, where Jamie said she heard the woman also say that she hates BB and loves the guests. They then discussed how much money they may be offered on Wednesday and whether they would take it or not. Eddie said no, and so did Josh. Jamie mentioned that \$100,000.00 is a lot of money. Curt said he would seriously consider it. George said he believes Teresa would tell him to stay in the house. He said that the chickenman has had the opportunity of a lifetime in the house, and it's really exciting!
- Cassandra and Curtis spoke privately in the backyard about the anticipated offer on Wednesday. Curtis said he is really torn. Cass said she believes the final days in the house will be amazing, and both agreed that they want to be the final three left in the house. They talked about how the public may feel about one of them taking the money, and whether they would be disappointed if they took it, or think they're stupid if they don't. Curtis said the offer adds excitement and mixes things up, but for him it's hard to think of this as a game show. Later, the group were treated to the viewing of

all of their audition tapes to get on BB. Josh's tape was first, where he talked about a vacation with three friends, and how he was really nervous with the girl he was with. After a few drinks, he kissed her in the back seat of the car and she almost jumped on him. George told his life story and said he is not a quitter. Jamie talked about her parents, and how she thinks Playboy is exciting. Curtis told BB about a girlfriend who cheated on him, and then sang opera. Eddie discussed how hard it would be to be in the house with good-looking girls and how he would have to tell Monica that things should be put on hold while he's away. Cassandra talked about a long term relationship that had ended because of her aspirations and professional life. They then showed a clip of her being quite funny, talking about the money and how she knows she can do it given the chance.

- That evening, they all discussed the videos, and Eddie made fun of Josh and Jamie's clips. Most of them were drinking, and Eddie was being quite obnoxious. George said he was worried about his business, and Curtis said maybe it will be downsized to zero. They all got a good laugh out of that. Jamie was shown in the Red Room discussing the dynamics of the house and how it has become quite mellow without Brit there. She said she feels she is getting to know the others on a deeper level and is talking to Cass much more now.
- Later, Jamie found Josh out by the pool all alone in the dark, and asked him what he was thinking about. He looked up and was crying. He said that he was thinking about his friends and the great expectations they have of him. He doesn't want them to concern themselves with his feelings, and fears living an empty life by himself. Jamie said she believes he will find the right person one day, but shouldn't have to be in a relationship to be happy. Josh said everyone he meets feels like he's taking over because he is on a different level than them. Jamie responded that the smarter he is, the harder time he has, and that people can't relate to him or are intimidated by him. Josh said he knows he should take the gifts he's been given and be happy. He said that if the world crushes him, and he dies feeling this way, but there's something better on the other side, he'll be happy.
- Curtis was shown in the Red Room telling BB that it would be great to win the money, but not at the expense of becoming competitive and cut-throat. He said he could not survive that way and it is really about the group of people he's living with, rather than a game show. BB asked him if he thinks the others feel the same way, and Curtis responded that they don't talk about it, and he can only guess on who would be cut-throat. Some are more competitive than others. The public was reminded once again that on Wednesday's live show, one of the guests would have the opportunity to leave the house with \$20,000.00. The show ended with Jamie dying George's hair green.

Day 64 (Wednesday, September 6, 2000) CBS Live Nomination Show 5

- The live show opened with Julie Chen advising us about the live challenge that will be presented to the house guests during the show. They will be offered \$20,000, for one of them to leave the house tonight. Julie introduced the replacement house guest, Beth, who will enter the house should one of the guests choose to leave with the money. Beth described herself as being determined, opinionated, goal-oriented, competitive. Her sister said she is melodramatic and a drama queen. Beth admitted that she will have trouble with Jamie in the house, because she doesn't like girls like Jamie and does not have a good opinion of Jamie thus far. She said she thinks she will get along well with Eddie, and believes the house will drive her crazy. Julie announced that Beth was a BB finalist but didn't originally make the cut. If she does enter the house and go on to win first prize, her prize will be pro-rated to the amount of time spent in the house, and she will win a maximum of \$140,000.00.
- The nominations for banishment were then announced, keeping in mind that if one of the guests leaves with the \$20,000 tonight, the nominations would be nullified:
 - Curtis - voted Eddie & George
 - Josh - voted Curtis & Cassandra
 - Cassandra - voted Eddie & Jamie
 - Eddie - voted Curtis & Cassandra
 - George - voted Josh & Curtis

- Jamie - voted Cassandra & Eddie
- The house guests were then advised that Curtis, Cassandra and Eddie all received three nominations and are marked for banishment. George, Jamie and Josh each received one nomination. The house guests had all dressed in army wear, with George wearing a huge plant hat on his head. When asked why, he said he has been attacked by air, speaker and TV. Curtis sent a Happy Birthday message to his mom.
- The house guests were then given their live challenge. They had received a warning about the challenge from an unknown person on the other side of the wall, however, Julie told them they don't have all the facts. Cassandra was asked to go into the Red Room to bring out whatever was on the chair. Cass did so and returned with a suitcase which she lay on the table in front of George. George opened it to find the \$20,000.00. Julie asked them each to consider the money, and to remember that three of them will be leaving the house with absolutely nothing. George said he has never seen \$20,000. All took turns touching the money, but Josh said he would rather see a McDonalds cheeseburger. Curtis asked them if anyone wanted the money. They all said no, and Julie acknowledged their decision. She then asked Josh to go into the Red Room and retrieve the next item on the chair. Josh returned with a second suitcase which he lay flat in front of Eddie. Eddie opened it to find an additional \$30,000.00. Julie then offered the guests \$50,000.00 to leave the house tonight. She gave them 1 minute to consider the offer. Curtis thought out loud about taking the money, and then said no. George talked to himself, then said no, saying he hopes he did the right thing Teresa. Julie went live to the guests and asked them for a decision. They all said no to the money, and Josh was asked to return the money to the Red Room. Julie then asked Beth what she thought of their decision, and Beth replied that she thinks they are insane.
- Dr. Drew Pinsky was then interviewed by Julie, and told her he is not surprised the guests turned down the money. He said there is a powerful dynamic in the house now. He also said he is not surprised they all said they would share the prize money six ways the other night, except for Eddie. Dr. Pinsky said Eddie wants to win the money. He also said that Jamie has trouble being honest with her true feelings, when asked about Brit leaving last week. Curtis' family were shown talking about how close they have become while watching Curtis in the BB house, and cheerleaders were also shown cheering Curtis on. Julie then interviewed the AOL spokesperson, who advised that the poll asking who would take the money showed 36% believed no one would take it. An instant AOL poll was run which asked if the public was surprised no one took the money. The response was 50/50 yes and no.
- Julie then showed an update on Karen's life since leaving the house. Karen has left her husband and moved her two girls to California. She has rented a house and was filmed arriving and checking it out. Brit arrived in California also to greet Karen, and the two were shown giving autographs at a restaurant. Karen said she feels like she has always given her life to others, and now feels like she is doing something for herself. Karen joined Julie in the studio and talked about how overwhelming the changes in her life have been since leaving the house. She said when she first left the house, she got online and checked out all the BB sites. She was very upset by all the negative posts online, however, received many positive phone calls from friends, and also from people all over the U.S. and Canada. An artist named Tony was shown, who creates paintings of the house guests. He paints pictures in 10 minutes and sells his art.
- Brittany was also in the studio and joined Julie for an interview. She said that she is having so much fun out of the house and will be moving to California also, and will stay with Karen for a short time. She said she has been watching lots of tapes since leaving the house and her opinions of some of the house guests have inevitably changed. She thinks more highly of Eddie, Curtis and Josh now, however, questions George, Jamie and Cassandra. She could not believe George's voting strategy, nor his family's actions. She was also hurt by Jamie, thinking they were really good friends, however, Jamie did not appear upset when she left the house. The guests were then told that Brit was in the studio and one of them will be given the opportunity to speak with her. They had one minute to decide who it would be. Of course, all of them pointed to Jamie, saying she should get the time, but Brit yelled out loud that she wanted to speak with Josh,

not Jamie. Julie said that Brit broke the rules, however, Josh entered the Red Room and listened to what Brit had to tell him. Brit immediately told him he can trust Curtis and Eddie but the others are questionable. She went on to say what George's family had done, and that the outside is a mean place. She gave him an update on Karen as well. Josh said he still loves her and they'll be friends forever. He also said that he will ignore what she said and that he trusts in God. He joined the others and said that Brit told him not to worry about the editing, but that she had said other things he was not going to tell them about. Julie asked Brit if she wanted Josh to tell the others what she had said, and she responded yes, however, understands why he did not.

- The show rapped up with everyone discussing the conversation with Brit and what Josh wouldn't tell them, and Cassandra looking quite disturbed.

Day 65 (Thursday, September 7, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opened with Curtis and Cassandra talking about being banished from the BB house, in the backyard. Cass said that once you're banished, you are cast out of the house. Curtis said it must be overwhelming. Cass said the most difficult part would be dealing with the public's love or hate for her. Curtis said he doesn't feel like anything has happened with him so it will be weird being in the public eye.
- Day 64 - All the house guests were in the yard, dressed in their army wear before the live show last night, when a plane flew by trailing the message "George backstabbing you in Red Room - banishgeorge.com" George ran in the house and came out with a pile of blankets, with which he tried to spell a message to the plane. Chiquita, however, ran through the blankets, messing the words up. George said the plane messages are pissing him off. Eddie told George that he now has a website, and George responded that that's just what he wants! George went in the house alone, and sat on the couch shaking his head. The house guests were shown trying to train Chiquita to follow the obstacle course, in order to win the weekly challenge. Each guest was shown talking about the pug and how lazy and unsmart she is.
- After the live show, Josh, Curtis and Eddie talked about the \$50,000.00 that was offered to them, laughing at how the public must perceive them turning it down. Eddie said that he's sure they are the laughing stock. He said he came into the house with \$3.00 in his pocket and now has turned down \$50,000.00. Curtis said he didn't even bring his wallet into the house. Eddie said everyone keeps saying they are there for the experience, but he believes they are all there for the money, or they would have taken the \$50,000.00 and left that night, because they had the experience. Curtis disagreed, saying he doesn't like the idea of missing out on the rest of the time in the house. Once you're committed, you want to go the distance. Eddie said he can see the public bouncing him out of the house, because they think he's money hungry.
- Jamie cornered Josh in the bedroom and asked him what Brit had said to him during the live show in the Red Room. She asked if Brit had said anything about her. When Josh said no, Jamie found that hard to believe, and accused Josh of being weird and not acting like himself. Josh said he is carrying a burden, and has made a decision not to tell the house guests what Brit said to him. Jamie asked again if it had anything to do with her, and Josh replied that it had to do with all the house guests, but it was nothing bad. Jamie then said that if it was nothing bad, why won't he share it? She then asked why Brit would yell out "no - Josh" when it looked like Jamie was going to be granted the conversation with Brit. Josh said that's just Brit being Brit. Jamie said she thinks it's weird because they were such good friends. Josh didn't say anything.
- Later, Curtis and Jamie discussed the offer of the money again, and Curtis said he's unsure why he didn't take the money and leave. He doesn't believe his chance to win the grand prize is as good as some of the others, and may kick himself when he does get banished. They both talked about some of the reasons for turning down the offer, stating it may be because they love it in the house so much; more exposure the longer they stay; not wanting to quit. Jamie asked Curtis what he would have done if BB offered them \$100,000.00 to leave. Curtis said he doesn't know, but it sure would have been harder to decide. Curtis said he is the closest to Jamie in the house.
- Josh was shown in the Red Room talking about the new information he now has since speaking with Brit last night, and how he feels the weight of the world on his

shoulders. He knows that Brit was trying to help him out, but thinks it would be bad to share the information with the group. He really wants everyone to get along in the house, but knows Brit will likely be mad at him for not telling them. He feels it's right to keep it to himself and wants Brit to know he knows she cares about him and to have some faith in him. He feels that if he tells the others about what she said, it would cause problems in the house, and he feels it's unfair. They should live their lives based on what they are doing in the house, and not what is going on outside of the house.

- The show ended with George and Jamie doing another infomercial, and then dancing like chickens.

Day 66 (Friday, September 8, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opened with Jamie and Cassandra lying in bed discussing the offer of \$50,000.00 the evening before and what their families would have told them to do. Cass said her Mom would trust her to make the right choice, but her sister would have told her to take the money. Jamie said she is unsure what her parents would say. Cass said there is something to be said for leaving the house with your head held high.
- Day 65 - Eddie and Jamie once again discussed the \$50,000.00, and Eddie suggested that all the house guests are in the house for the money, and not the experience as they have always said. He proposed to Jamie that once the prize money has been distributed to the last three house guests, that they then share the money six ways as previously discussed, giving each of them \$108,000.00. Jamie said that was not the original deal; they talked about sharing the money now, not having to go through the competitions and nominations, and enjoying the last 30 days in the house. Jamie said the last three weeks in the house will be the best. Ed responded that Jamie has yet to experience the feeling of being nominated for banishment, and that it is really cool and part of the game. Eddie said he has better things to do than spend three months in the house, and is not there for the experience, but rather, for the money to provide for his family. The odds of him winning were 1 in 10, and are now 1 in 6. Jamie asked him about the exposure and possible fame he may receive because of his time in the house, but Ed replied that he would have done it with no cameras in the house at all.
- Jamie was shown in the Red Room talking about the \$50,000.00 yet again. She believes that everyone in the house could use the money, and she has many student loans to pay back. She said that she is really going to go after a career, and knows that is a financially dumb decision. She went on to say that if BB offered \$100,000.00 - \$200,000.00 to George, and in return, Jamie must leave the house, she would go because George really needs the money. BB asked her then that if she won the grand prize, would she share some of it with George. Jamie paused for a very long time, then said "that's a good question", then mumbled for a while and stared off into space.
- Later, all the house guests were in the kitchen, when the plane flew by trailing a message that read "Josh knows why we fly anti-George banners". The house guests discussed it quietly, trying to keep the message from George. George then joined them in the kitchen, and Eddie told him BB had asked them to stay in the house, and that there's a plane but they didn't see the message. George peered through the windows until he finally saw, and read the message. He instantly became upset and walked away from the others. Josh went to him in the living room, hugged him and said "in one ear and out the other". George went to the Red Room and asked BB what was with the banners. BB replied that they have nothing to do with it. George became angry and said that he is not quitting, and let "him" fly his plane and spend all his money on banners. The house guests were asked to discuss the social implications of the week's nominations for banishment. A discussion ensued about the three up for banishment being black, Asian and disabled. Cass talked about being black and how that impacts how she lives in the house, and why she has been nominated so many times. Curtis explained that they are each seen as a character, and he is seen as the Asian lawyer, Jamie as the beauty queen, etc. Eddie didn't see this as being an issue, stating that the walls don't see color.
- The house guests were given a daily challenge to play the price is right game. Products of interest to each guest were displayed on the table, and each of them had to take a turn on the prices and be right within \$1.00. Curtis' product was a T-shirt; George had a

box of chocolates; Eddie had beers of the world; Cass had hair mayonnaise; Josh had a disposable razor and Jamie had coffee syrup. The only person to guess within the \$1.00 was Cassandra who guessed Curtis' \$12.00 T-shirt at \$12.50. BB announced to the public that on Saturday night, the winner of the daily challenge will win a trip to the Emmy Awards, and will get to rub elbows with the rich and famous. On Monday, we will get to hear all about it. The show ended with the guests in the back yard looking at a beautiful sunset.

Day 67 (Saturday, September 9, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with a review of the previous week, including training Chiquita for the weekly challenge, the discussion on splitting the prize money six ways, and the live show on Wednesday including the \$50,000.00 offer, and Brit and Josh's discussion in the Red Room. The group was also shown drinking beer and Cass telling them she has never been drunk. George told Cassandra he likes to drink and enjoys it, but does not drink to get wasted. Josh was shown chugging one beer after another, and George told Cass that Eddie had drank 12 beer. Various plane banners were shown again, including "George is backstabbing you in the RR - banishgeorge.com" and "Josh knows why we fly anti-George banners".
- Day 66 - Curtis, Josh and Eddie were shown sitting around the kitchen table talking about farting, and blaming the dog. Curtis said he thinks it's funny when Josh waits for Jamie & Cass to leave the room before farting, yet it is shown on national TV. Cassandra and Eddie talked in the kitchen about Josh keeping the news he heard from Brit a secret from the house guests. Both agreed that they think Josh is genuine and is trying to protect them by not telling them what he knows. At noon, the group conducted the obstacle course with Chiquita, using food to encourage her to complete the various obstacles. Chiquita completed the course successfully and the house guests won the weekly challenge of 20% more of their grocery money.
- The house guests were told that one of them will be given the opportunity to attend the Emmy Awards on Sunday night, with no strings attached. The group discussed this news quite skeptically, not believing that the person who goes will be allowed to re-enter the BB house after the awards show has finished. They all agreed that if attending the show meant leaving the BB house permanently, no one was interesting in going. Jamie asked if anyone would go if BB gave them \$50,000.00 as well as the trip to the Emmys. No one really answered the question. George said that he originally wanted to make it to the halfway point in the BB house, and would be willing to walk out of the house to save one of the others from banishment. Eddie replied that if George leaves to save his *ss, Ed will kick George's *ss when he leaves the BB house. George laughed, saying Eddie could never kick his *ss. Later, BB assured the house guests that whoever attends the Emmys will be able to return to the BB house after the show. They were told that a gold ticket for the show was hidden somewhere inside the house, and whoever finds it will be the one to go to the show. They all turned the house upside down looking for the ticket, and finally, Curtis found it taped to the back of the Red Room door. Curtis was then shown in the Red Room telling BB how excited he was to be going to the Emmys and how he has never won a challenge before.
- That evening, they all sat in the living room drinking beer and talking about Curtis' trip out of the house on Sunday. Eddie offered pizza to one of the live cameras, and then told the camera off for moving away from him, (it was funny). Jamie and Curtis tried to guess what Josh was keeping from them after his discussion with Brit. Josh told them they can figure it out for themselves, by thinking about the timeframe of the house and the various banners that have been flow overhead. He said that they should base what they know on what has happened whilst they have been in the house, and that nothing has been a lie.
- Day 67 - First thing in the morning, George told Jamie that it was obvious all along, and that it was in front of them all this time. The group is then shown saying all at once "we'll bail on Wednesday". It looked like a joke, but actually, this is serious news. I suggest you check the live feeds for September 9.

Day 69 (Monday, September 11, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 67. George and Eddie were complaining about no hot water for the shower, and George told Eddie to go back to bed until the hot water is available. George told Jamie that at 10:00 a.m. he wants to have a group meeting. He kept saying "it's so obvious, it was right in front of us all this time, I've figured it out". At 10:00 the group gathered around the dining room table and George told them that he has figured it out. He said that there is more to the show than banishment and challenges. The show is meant to tell the world that if they all stick together, they win. They could have walked out as nine winners. George told them that when he was nominated for banishment, he had some fun by making signs that read "save our hero" and "save George". He then held them up to the cameras, but nothing happened. He said that he stepped out on his own, but BB is trying to break them apart and pit them against each other. When Curtis won the ticket to the Emmy Awards, it fell into place. They needed Curtis to be on Entertainment Tonight. They need the group - if they walk out as one, they all win. George went on to say that he has been reading the BB manual, and that if they all walk out, there won't be a show, and the house guests hold all the cards. The planes have been telling them all along, and they will all walk out as winners if they go out as one.
- Josh then told the group about Brit's conversation with him last week, and what she had told him about George's family and town. Eddie said that he doesn't trust the sky (planes), BB or even the house guests, and that he's not walking out. George said that the show is trying to prove a point; it's not about popularity, but rather, that people can join together as one and they will win. Cass asked Josh if Brit had said that since no one can win against George and his family, they should all walk? Josh said that's not what she had said. Jamie said she can see CBS bringing in six alternates if they do a group walk-out. George said there is a risk in doing this, however, the money is bullsh*t and the point to make is to stick together. He said that there is so much money out there for them and that they have a real chance to do something as a group. Curtis said that the challenges are made so that they can all win together, and perhaps that is the point of the show. George said they have a chance to make history. Eddie responded that they will be looked at as either six winners, or six quitters that couldn't take the last three weeks. George repeatedly said that they are not quitters, and that their families would be proud of them.
- After much more discussion, and for reasons unknown to me, they all agreed, including Eddie, to walk out as a group on Wednesday. Josh later told Curtis alone what Brit had said about him only being able to trust Curtis and Eddie. That the others in the house were questionable. Josh said he hated having that knowledge, and knew people would question his friendship if he said anything about it. He was relieved that it had all finally come out. Later, he told Jamie the same thing with Curtis close by. Jamie responded that the news did not make sense to her, and that she wishes she didn't hear it. Why would her close friend say that? Josh told her not to overanalyze the information.
- The rest of the show was basically all of them discussing the walk out on Wednesday during the live show. Josh said he doesn't want to backstab to get the money, but would rather work for it. Cass said this decision allows her to step out of the game feeling good about it. Curtis said the money is not as important as getting along with the house guests, and that integrity is priceless. George said he has never sat at a table with a finer group of people, as he wiped away a tear. The show ended with Eddie taking the pictures of Monica off his wall and packing them into his BB suitcase, while saying he knows he's an idiot.

Day 70 (Tuesday, September 12, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 68. The house guests were given their weekly challenge - a juggling contest with which they must each juggle three balls and can only drop two balls between the five of them left on Friday. After much joking about screwing over the alternates that will be put in the place of the departing house guests on Wednesday night, they agreed to wager 50% of their grocery money. The group sat together in the living room, discussing the planned walk-out on Wednesday, and how they should go about telling BB officially, when BB's voice (John) boomed over the speaker. He said to

them that they do not need to come into the Red Room to announce their decision, and that BB has already begun making arrangements to fly their families to the studio for Wednesday night. He said that they have all had a long day and he hopes they get some rest and they'll talk more about the arrangements tomorrow. Jamie looked quite disturbed as John spoke. Everyone was silent when he finished, and George said that something doesn't seem right. Jamie asked the group what would happen if they stayed in the house and refused to nominate each other for banishment. Curtis and Josh explained that to stay, they must follow BB's rules. Eddie said that they are forfeiting the game, but winning for themselves. Both Cassandra and Jamie looked very unhappy.

- Jamie went into the Red Room and told BB how quickly things had changed in the house during the day. She wants to make sure she is making the right decision and has concerns for her future plans if she walks out on a TV show. Later, the group again discussed the walk-out, and Josh said that if one person is wavering, it doesn't work. Eddie said he has been wavering since the beginning of the discussion. Cass said that she believes she will be the one to be voted out of the house on Wednesday, and thinks it is fine to sacrifice one person and the others stay and go on with the show. Someone came up with the idea that they all nominate each other so that they are all up for banishment, and then it would become the public's decision who gets voted out of the house. Josh said that if they stay past Wednesday, three people's lives will be changed forever because of the prize money. The benefit to leaving though is to show that society is not about greed. Eddie suggested that they all take some time to think about the events of the day, and that they should discuss the matter further tomorrow. Curtis said there are two issues at hand; one that one of three will be voted out on Wednesday (Cass, Curtis or Eddie), plus George has stated he is leaving Wednesday either way. George said he doesn't know what to do and wants the group to agree as a whole.
- Eddie in the Red Room talked about being out the money if he walks with the group. George pushed them all over the edge with this idea, and they may all decide to leave on Wednesday. He came in the house with no money and can leave with no money. He knows he will be a better person when he leaves the house, and said that the time in there was a vacation and the rollercoaster will begin the day he walks out. Jamie and Eddie later discussed the walk-out privately, and Jamie said she believes they can stay and still accomplish their goals. She doesn't like the thought of quitting. Eddie said that nothing has changed and perhaps they should continue on with the nominations as they always have in the past. Jamie said it is hard for them to nominate two house guests. Eddie said he doesn't see as much personal satisfaction walking out of the house, and believes he will regret it later.
- Day 69 - A plane flew over the house trailing a banner. The house guests warned Jamie that she's about to get bombed. The banner read "Jamie, Brit knows UR 2 Faced ????.com" (I couldn't read the website on the banner). Jamie looked upset about the words, while Eddie yelled that he is jealous he's not getting any messages. The group all joked about the various planes flying over with messages, and Josh told Jamie not to get stressed about it. Curtis dressed in a tuxedo for the Emmy Awards and left the house at 1:30, with all the house guests gathered around wishing him luck. Josh was shown in the Red Room talking about the walk-out, and telling BB that if it was just him he would stay, but he hates to see people hurting. George is torn up inside and he hates to see that. Later, George and Josh hugged each other, after Josh told George about his wife's campaign against Brit. George said he is proud of Josh for telling him and that he is leaving on Wednesday. Josh said he has done nothing wrong and has no reason to leave the house. George replied that if they all leave, they all win. The show ended with the house guests practicing their juggling for the weekly challenge.

Day 71 (Wednesday, September 13, 2000) CBS Live Banishment Show 5

- Julie Chen opened the live show, beginning with the house guests rebellion and supposed planned walk-out during tonight's show. An update on the rebellion and the changing of minds of most of the house guests were then viewed. Julie then went live to the house guests, asking George if he still plans to leave the BB house tonight. George said he is staying. When asked if he is disappointed that the house guests have

decided to stay in the house, he responded "not at this point, no". Julie reminded them that last week, they had all turned down the offer of \$50,000.00 to leave the house. She then asked Josh to go to the Red Room and bring out the suitcase placed on the chair. Josh did so and placed the suitcase in front of George as instructed by Julie. George then opened the suitcase to find a piece of paper, a pen, and a toy airplane. Julie explained that the airplane banners have become a part of their lives recently, and they now have an opportunity to create their own message banner, which will be flown in the sky later during the show. They were given two minutes to compose their banner.

- Cuzzy's Bar in Minneapolis was shown, where Brit's family and friends were throwing a birthday party for Brit who turned 26 years old on September 9. Brit told CBS she is having the time of her life since leaving the house. Julie then reminded the viewers about Curtis' trip to the Emmy Awards on Sunday, and we were shown clips of the experience including the tuxedo, limo ride, champaign, the red carpet, TV stars and interviews. Curtis seemed to really enjoy himself. Dr. Drew Pinsky was interviewed and asked about the Emmy Awards prize. Dr. Drew stated that it seemed to refuel Curtis, and he now seems to have a more positive attitude about BB. He believes Curtis is emerging as the leader of the group but needs to assert himself more. Julie then asked Dr. Drew how he thinks George was able to convince the house guests to walk out. Dr. Drew explained that George has a lot of feelings in the house, and the group has really meshed together. One can affect all as was clearly shown on Saturday. The plane banners, now called "the sky" were discussed and Dr. Drew said he believes they create an element of anxiety for the house guests. They never know what to expect and it unsettles them. Their own banner may empower them tonight.
- Jamie's family and friends were shown having a party in the Seattle Planet Hollywood, to show their support for her. The house guests were then shown cleaning the house and doing regular chores that need to be done. Julie told the house guests it was time for her to announce the banished house guest, and went on to say the votes were very close for Eddie and Cassandra. Eddie received 41% of the votes, however, Cassandra received 46%. Therefore, Cass was asked to say goodbye to everyone and leave the house. As always, they hugged each other and Cassandra walked down the path to find her mother and friend waiting for her. The crowd seemed quite large and very loud. The other house guests went to the backyard to hear the crowd. Josh speculated that there were a lot of people out there. All looked quite upset about losing Cassandra. George sat alone doubled over, and appeared to be crying. Josh hugged Jamie.
- Cass entered the studio and was greeted by two friends who told her "you did us proud". Julie interviewed Cass, first asking her how she feels. Cass responded that she feels great to be there and thanked everyone for the warm welcome. She also said she is concerned about the house guests, and they have become so much like a family, she doesn't want them to be depressed. Julie asked her about her apparent isolation in the early days of the house, and the bonding during the last days. Cass explained that she was very cautious and conservative and did not participate in activities she was not comfortable with. Her role in the house was to be strong and even, and she believes someone else will step up to the plate now that she is gone, suggesting that that person may be Jamie. Cass told Julie that she went into the house for the experience and to be challenged and she feels that she learned a lot about herself during her stay in the house. Cass was then shown clips of her time in the house, include counselling the others, her hair issues, and not participating in the love-bed. Cass said it was hilarious. She said that she was always aware of the cameras and how she appeared on video. She does not regret saying no to the \$50,000.00 last week, and said she left the house with her integrity and did not want to sell her soul for money.
- Julie asked Cass whether she held back on her comments at times, showing the clip of Eddie talking about race not being an issue in America, and Jamie's conversation about white vs. black America. Cass responded that you have to pick and choose the times to say things in the house, and most of the time it is better to get into debates one on one, rather than in a group. She did not share everything about herself in the house, wanting to keep some things private. She expected to be banished tonight because of the clues that were received during the past week, namely the plane banner that told

the guests to stay in the house except Cass. When asked how George persuaded them all to rebel and walk out on Wednesday, Cass explained that they were all frustrated with nominating people and the banishment process, and were all feeling emotional about that. George hit them at a good time and had compelling arguments for them to walk out. Cass was given the opportunity to say goodbye live to the guests, and she told them not to be sad. George told her to call Teresa, and Cass said she will talk to all of their families.

- Julie announced that from now on, Saturday shows will be live one hour episodes, with nominations for banishment, and Wednesday shows will continue to be live one hour episodes announcing the banished house guest. The plane banner that the house guests had composed was flown over the house reading "Live long and prosper GAB" (GAB being George's initials). The five looked quite depressed and sad and Jamie left the guys to lay in the bedroom alone.

Day 72 (Thursday, September 14, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 69 (Sunday) and Curtis returning to the BB house from the Emmy Awards. All the house guests followed him around the house asking him questions about what the awards were like. Curtis told them about the limosine ride, the booze, and the interviews while on the red carpet. He said that it was very weird to be outside the house, and that it gave him an appreciation for life. He said that they should save every moment in the house while they are there, and that they should stay and not walk out as they had previously planned. He described the awards arrival, saying there were USC people there cheering for him, the press were taking his picture, and he did a live interview with Melissa Rivers. When asked who designed the tuxedo he was wearing, he replied "it's a big brother special". He also said that he met Rudy, and that it was clear people know who they are.
- Day 70 - Eddie and George discussed the upcoming banishment, and Eddie suggested that perhaps he will be the one to leave the house on Wednesday. George looked upset with this news, and said he is rooting for Eddie. Eddie said that if he does make it past Wednesday, he will shake things up in the house. In the Red Room, he told BB that from now on, he will be playing the game strategically to protect his best interests. BB asked him if it will be emotionally tough on him to nominate the other house guests, and Eddie responded no, and he hopes to be up against George for banishment. He felt that it would be fun for the public, since George is a controversial house guest.
- That afternoon, a plane flew over the house trailing a sign that read "George is sexist and racist in the Red Room". This initiated a house discussion about the significance of the plane messages and the impact it has on the house guests. Jamie suggested that they not talk about the messages so as not to feed into "storylines". Curtis replied that they have no control of what is going on in the outside world, and that they should acknowledge the messages, and discuss them, not bottle their feelings up inside. Jamie responded that they have to respect each other when it comes to the messages. (No mention or viewing of the BBFC banner was aired tonight).
- Later, the house guests played a game of croquet, and the guys began to tease Jamie about how she secretly suntanned with her platform shoes on. Eddie then talked about the boys all running around with sticks and balls, and Jamie did not look impressed.
- Day 71 - Jamie and Curtis talked privately in the washroom about the croquet game the evening before. Jamie accused the guys of being distasteful towards women on national TV. She would never say some of the things they so frequently say about other house guests. She talked about creating storylines again and asked Curtis about the suntanning comments. Curtis seemed quite surprised about how sensitive Jamie was, and tried to defend himself, saying that he doesn't feel that he did anything wrong. Jamie felt misunderstood and a small argument ensued. After, they both agreed that this portion would likely not make it to TV because Jamie did not have her microphone on. Jamie tried to see the cameramen through the mirror glass in the washroom.
- Day 72 - The house guests were shown after Cassandra's banishment, congratulating Eddie and Curtis for making it through. Both began to unpack and Eddie yelled that this is fun and exciting! Curtis said he finds the banishment part the hardest part of the experience in the house. Both agreed that they wouldn't unpack because they'll likely

be up for banishment again next week. The group made dinner and talked fondly of Cassandra. The show finished with clips of everyone hugging Cassandra goodbye on Wednesday night.

Day 73 (Friday, September 15, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 72 - The five house guests were all in the bedroom, and Eddie said that since they were all together, he had something to say. He said that he is honored to be in the house, and glad they have all come to an agreement that nominations are nothing personal, and to enjoy their time in the house. He wished them all luck, but went on to say that he is now going to play the game strategically. He has become wiser from his time in the house and repeated that again, the nominations are not to be taken personally. He asked everyone that if they have any problems with him, to talk to him privately. All of them looked quite surprised by what he had said.
- Curtis in the Red Room told BB that they are down to half a roll of toilet paper, and asked if there was any chance they could have an advance on toilet paper until next groceries. BB answered no. Jamie in the Red Room told BB they are now completely out of toilet paper. BB told her that since it is their budget, and they are the ones that create the grocery list, it is their fault they are out of toilet paper. He told her that they have an extra \$40.00, and they can choose to spend the entire amount on toilet paper, or wait until Friday (2 days) for the groceries to arrive. He mentioned that other BB houses had also run out of toilet paper, and one of them were out for a whole week. Jamie conferred with the house guests about the toilet paper situation, and they agreed that since their chance of winning the weekly juggling challenge was slim, and they would need the \$40.00, they will wait until Friday for toilet paper.
- Eddie, Josh and George discussed Eddie's disability, while laying in bed. Eddie said that he is always limited to what he can do because of his missing leg, and could never be in Hollywood, because he would always be seen with one leg. Josh argued that Eddie was limiting himself.
- Day 73 - The house guests were all in the backyard when a plane flew over trailing the message "G signals who 2 vote out - points at your mask". George laughed and said it took them all day to drop a bomb on the chicken. He said he didn't care and they can fly all the damn planes they want. He said to the house guests that he doesn't know what to tell them. Eddie made a joke that he would cut George's finger off if he catches him pointing to his mask. George then went to the Red Room, wearing an apron and a chefs hat, and told BB that maybe he should stay in the bedroom in the dark all day. He said he tries not to think about the bad things, but realizes that the others may be thinking there is some truth to all the negative messages being flown over the house about him. Later, Curtis was shown in the Red Room telling BB that he doesn't know whether he should nominate George for banishment. He said it would be a gamble to be up for banishment against George because of his wife's campaign to keep him in the house.
- The house guests were given a daily challenge, with a reward of the "crown jewels". Whoever wins the challenge will win three votes, and can nominate three people, or one person twice, plus another person. The challenge is for them to make up their own challenge that majority agrees on. After some discussion, they all agreed they did not want to participate in this challenge, because it would create an unfair advantage to the winner, and they all believe it should be even. Josh suggested that if they have to do the challenge, they play 5 card draw. Josh then went into the Red Room to ask BB if they had to do the challenge. BB asked why they would choose not to do it, and Josh explained their reasons. BB gave them the okay not to do the challenge, and Josh joined the others for dinner, telling them what happened.
- The house guests were given another challenge - to write lyrics to the BB theme song. They were given a tape player and listened to the music over and over breaking the song into five parts and assigning a part to each house guest. Curtis and Jamie both thought this challenge would be fun. Eddie, outside on the weight bench, yelled at Chiquita who was eating something over by a Happy Birthday sign Jamie had set up for her brother, Denis Jr. Curtis went over to see what the dog was eating, and discovered

she had managed to open the full box of rice crispies Jamie had used to make the sign. The pug was chowing down when Curtis reached her. Eddie and Curtis began laughing so hard, Jamie came out to see what was going on. They told her that Chiquita had opened the bag and had put her face into the cereal. Apparently, earlier she had been eating chicken poop. Jamie looked at the box and said it was barely open. Eddie and Curtis laughed even harder at Jamie's words telling her she can eat the cereal if she wants, but they're not touching it. Jamie went inside the house and did not look too pleased with the guys.

- Later, Eddie asked Jamie what she sees when she looks at the walls, meaning what is this about to her. Jamie said it's about the experience, and she's never lived with people before. She said she gets to do cool stuff, and that there's more to it than winning the game for her. Eddie said he doesn't feel that way, and that he only sees it as a game.

Day 74 (Saturday, September 16, 2000) CBS Live Nomination Show 6

- Julie Chen opened the first live show on a Saturday night, explaining that this is a nomination show. She began the show by telling the houseguests that they have a combination challenge and reward. They will have a total time of five minutes for all of them to make one personal phone call to the person of their choice. They will be timed and their time begins from the moment they enter the Red Room until the moment they leave. They must ask the person they're calling if they have their permission to air their voice live. They must make the calls in alphabetical order, and cannot give up their phone call to give more time to the others. The phone calls went like this:
 - Curtis - phoned his Mom - she told him to be nice and maintain his integrity. It was cool to see him on the Emmy Awards. Jen's baby will be a boy.
 - Eddie - phone his Mom - she loves him and misses him. Eddie told her he'll send her a message via Internet at 6:00 pm each evening.
 - George - phoned wife Teresa - asked her if it's okay to stay in the house and is he being trashed. She responded to stay in the house. He hung up on her and ran out of the room.
 - Jamie - phoned her Mom - Mom told her she loves her, misses her, she's still Miss Washington and to hang with Curtis and Josh and stay strong. Jamie repeated said "love you mommy".
 - Josh - phoned his step-dad - mis-dialed the first attempt, then could not get a dial tone. Tried again and only had 25 seconds to speak. His step-dad told him he's doing great and to hang in there.
- After the phone calls, the houseguests excited told each other what happened. Josh told them about his mis-dial and seemed disappointed. George was dressed in a space outfit and the audience kept laughing at him. He said he has peace of mind now knowing they're being portrayed okay. Julie told them their second surprise for the evening is announcing their nominations live in the Red Room. Each will have one minute privately to announce who they are nominating and why. The nominations went like this throughout the entire show.
 - Eddie - voted Jamie & George - said they are both positive people but would like to see the public vote it out.
 - Josh - voted Curtis & George - feels they will both be okay without the prize money, whereas the others need the money more.
 - Curtis - voted Eddie & George - feels closer to the others than Eddie & George so has no choice.
 - George - voted Jamie & Curtis - won't nominate Eddie and has voted for Josh too many times already.
 - Jamie - Eddie & George - rolled the dice - all are good people and all deserve to win.
 - Total = George (4); Curtis (2); Jamie (2); Eddie (2); Josh (0).
- A Texas town 1000 miles away from Rockford, Illinois held a town rally for George and had Teresa and the three children at the rally. The mayor of the town said they are sponsoring George and will give him a key to the town. Julie interviewed Dr. Drew Pinsky who thought that the live nominations would shock the houseguests and make

them anxious. He expects they will be more honest about the nominations. He also said that the phone calls will have a great influence on them since outside information always changes their feelings. When asked about Jamie being the only woman left in the house, Dr. Drew felt that the atmosphere had turned "fraternity like" and that Jamie is uncomfortable with the jokes. She will need to assert herself more and her show of strength will be viewed more positively in her favor.

- Julie then interviewed Regina Lewis from AOL who said that the Internet is picking up steam as the show progresses and the poll asking who will win the prize money is shown as Curtis 24%; Josh 24%; Eddie 23%; George 22%; Jamie 7%. Clips of Jamie looking for "Bob", one of the BB cameramen were shown, with Jamie saying Bob's name and peering through the glass trying to get a view of him. A video clip of Eddie's wheelchair basketball team was shown. His team-mates said that Eddie is obnoxious and swears a lot but has a big heart.
- A Seattle fair was shown where a BB contest was being held. A glass house had been installed where 12 people lived in the house with constant people looking in the windows at them. The winner will win \$10,000.00. Various websites were shown including the BB movies, games, and music (no mention of the BBFC).
- Julie announced to the houseguests who were nominated for banishment. George reacted very strongly, realizing immediately that all four had nominated him for banishment. He laughed and laughed repeatedly saying "all four of you voted for the chicken". Curtis responded "you don't know that George". Jamie and Eddie in particular looked very uncomfortable. The show ended with Julie telling the viewers to pay particular attention to the phone message when calling to vote.

Day 76 (Monday, September 18, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 74 and the house guests performing their juggling challenge for 50% of their grocery money. Curtis dropped one ball first, then Jamie, then Jamie again. They were advised by BB that they had failed the weekly challenge, that three balls had been dropped, plus George and Jamie did not have a ball in the air at all times. The house guests later worked on their musical challenge, to write lyrics for the BB theme song. Curtis ran the show with Eddie sitting on the floor, playing with Chiquita and not participating in the challenge.
- Jamie and Eddie discussed nominations while alone in the backyard. Jamie asked Eddie if he liked all the house guests equally, and wanted them all to win, would he roll a dice to decide who to nominate. Eddie replied no, because you will always care for some more than others, you must rank people in order, and you have to put yourself first. Later, Jamie and Josh spoke alone, and Josh said that the worst thing in life is not being genuine and not saying what you mean. He said he swims underwater when things are bothering him, and he can scream under there and it feels like his own universe.
- Day 75 - All the house guests were in the backyard when a plane message flew overhead that read "Wake the F up anti-G banners are true - Fans not CBS". This message seemed to upset the house guests and George immediately went to the Red Room to tell BB that the messages are not cool anymore. He said he is unable to just blow it off anymore, and for all he knows, he could be the most hated man in America. He doesn't know because he's in the house. Later, Eddie and Curtis discussed Jamie's problem with nominations, and Eddie told Curtis about their conversation the evening before. Eddie said he believes Jamie is denying herself of the experience. Not much time later, Jamie went into the Red Room to talk to BB, but the guys were laughing so hard in the living room, she couldn't concentrate on what she wanted to say. The guys were laughing about the fact that George received four nominations on Saturday, and the look on the others faces when they realized they had all nominated George. Jamie didn't know this and came out to ask them what they were laughing about. They wouldn't tell her, and pretended like it was about her. Curtis said he'd tell her later. Jamie looked paranoid.
- Day 76 - George acted out another one of his famous infomercial with Jamie pretending to be the host. George dressed in his space costume again and announced that the Chickenman is about to blast off to another planet. He has four nominations, and does

not know what's going to happen on the outside. He entered the shower where his "spaceship" was waiting for him, buckled himself in, and asked Jamie to close the shower door. Jamie did so, also shutting the curtain over the door. As Jamie counted down from 10, George opened pop bottles that fizzed and then kind of exploded all over him. He opened the door laughing, and said "the Chickenman has to go back to the drawing board". As Jamie thanked everyone for watching the first attempt of the Chickenman to blast off into outer space, George slipped and fell on the spilt pop.

- The house guests were given their daily challenge, to find Chiquita. The winner of the challenge would be given the opportunity to broadcast the weather live on CBS. The house guests entered the backyard to find at least 30 pugs running around. Their task was to identify Chiquita. Some of the pugs were black and one had only three legs. After checking as many as they could, Curtis went back to the bedroom to read the instructions again, while Josh ran to the Red Room. He told BB that he believes Chiquita is not outside with all of the pugs and has been hidden inside the house. He suggested the storage room, and BB told him to check there. He did, to discover he was right, and Chiquita was in the room. Josh won the challenge.
- Eddie was shown in the Red Room telling BB how different he and Jamie are. He said that Jamie believes everything can be fixed with a smile and a hug, and she clams up when something is bothering her. He said he is different and is very competitive, where she is not. He finished by saying he knows he pisses her off sometimes.

Day 77 (Tuesday, September 19, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 76 and the new weekly challenge called "In the news". The house guests were given 25 headlines, and have to decide whether they are true or false. They will be given 25 more headlines every day until Thursday noon, when they will have to say whether the headlines are true or false. All agreed to wager 50% of their grocery money. To review the headlines, check the Daily Feeds section. Eddie was shown playing with Chiquita, scaring her and making her run away.
- Day 77 - George dressed up in his costume for the BB recording session. He was dressed in army fatigues with a banner on his head. He painted a heart with Teresa above it on one arm, pretending it was a tattoo, and thought he wrote "MA" on the other arm but actually wrote it backwards spelling "AM". When he showed the house guests, they all had a good laugh. All the house guests went into the Red Room to record the lyrics they had written for the BB theme song. After some practice, and a lot of laughter, the final take, called "Into our lives" was recorded. It was very well done (I must say)! After, the house guests continued with Monday's 25 headlines, which included one that read "BB fans thwarted in attempt to catapult toilet paper over wall". Of course, this was the BBFC Angels first mission, however, the house guests laughed and said it was false because they assumed the Angels would have been able to accomplish the task. Other headlines were "Jordan has her own show" which apparently is true, and "Brit signed by major Hollywood talent agent" which also is true.
- After winning the Running of the Pugs contest, Josh got ready for his prize, to broadcast the weather live on CBS. He wore his swimsuit only, stood out by the pool after sunset, and talked back and forth with the KCBS anchors live. He then announced the current temperature at 69 degrees, and was given a live quiz, to identify what out of three words had to do with the weather. Josh guessed Gynophobia, which turned out to be a fear of women, when the actual right answer was Brontophobia, fear of lightning. The other choice was Ablutophobia which is the fear of showering or bathing. Josh then went on to announce the weather in each of the house guests' home town. When finished he dived into the pool. BB told him "well done Josh".
- The house guests marked for banishment were each given the opportunity to plead their case to stay in the house, in the Red Room. They had 30 seconds only, and Curtis went first thanking everyone for keeping him in the house so far, after being nominated four times already. He said he would love to stay. Jamie went next saying she prays every day to stay until the end and would like to pay for her half sister's college education, pay off her student loans, allow her parents to retire and not be a poor Hollywood actress. Eddie went third saying he is too proud to beg and has enjoyed his time in the house. He said that he has good friends, and good books on the outside

but would love to stay, and has learned a lot about himself. George went last, telling everyone they should volunteer to take a kid to school, and that he would love to stay in the house but volunteering is more important.

- Next, again in the Red Room, the marked guests were then asked to plead for someone else to stay in the house. George went first, saying everyone has followed his path with his relationship with Eddie, and they must do what they have to do, Curtis said he likes everyone in the house, but would plea for Jamie to stay. Jamie said that Curtis is an integral part of the house and makes them laugh every day. Eddie's plea was for George to stay, saying he is a good man and ultimately wants to provide for his family. The show ended with the house guests recording "Into our Lives".

Day 78 (Wednesday, September 20, 2000) CBS Live Banishment Show 6

- Julie Chen opened the live show announcing that a former house guest will be re-entering the BB house at some point during this week. She then went live to the house guests, and asked Jamie how she felt being up for banishment for the first time. Jamie responded that it's not one of her favorite things, and she hasn't eaten much today. George, dressed in a toga, with a wreath around his newly dyed blonde hair, said he was going for the refreshing look. The camera showed signs hanging on the wall that George had made which read "Chicken George needs a job" and "92 Ford Pick-up for sale". He told Julie he has the feeling the Chickenman will fly the coop tonight. When asked how he felt that all the house guests had nominated him for banishment, he said that it was the first laugh he had all week.
- Julie explained to the house guests the new challenge of one of the former house guests returning to the house this week. She told them they will have to choose who returns to the house, and they can ask any questions they would like to that person. They then watched videos of each of the former house guests who explained to them why they should be chosen to return to the house. After some discussion, the group agreed on Cassandra to re-enter the house, since she is the most articulate and will tell them everything. Julie then showed some video footage of Jerry Hider with Airbanners.com who explained how much business he has received since BB began. Jamie's Mom said that she sent a banner for Jamie because she wanted to cheer her up. Eddie's Mom said she sent the banner for Eddie because he was ready to leave the house.
- Julie then interviewed Dr. Drew Pinsky, first raising the issue of the four nominations against George. Dr. Drew said that all the house guests expressed regret during the nominations, and George took the news very well. It could have been very tense, and all the house guests looked guilty when George realized all four had nominated him. Dr. Drew said he was not surprised the house guests chose Cassandra to return to the house because they always felt that they could rely on her. Julie mentioned that Cassandra does not watch the show, nor has she watched any of the taped footage of her time in the house. Dr. Drew believes that she will still have plenty of information to share with the guests when she arrives back in the house. Video was then shown of Cassandra's friends and family throwing a welcome home party for her in a restaurant, and Cassandra giving autographs to some fans.
- Julie interviewed Regina Lewis, AOL spokesperson, who said the Internet is heating up and getting bigger by the minute. A poll was run regarding which of the house guests would have a career opportunity after leaving the house, and the results were: Brit 40%, Jamie 20%, Josh 17%, and the rest were all single digits. It was then time to announce to the house guests which of the four is banished from the house. The results were: Curtis 3%, Eddie 14%, Jamie 32% and George 51%. George then said his goodbyes to the house guests, gathered his things and left the house still dressed in the toga. His three daughters were waiting for him at the gate, and the crowd cheered loudly for him. He kept asking his girls if everything has been cool, over and over. During this reunion, the house guests went out in the back yard to listen to the cheers, and could hear a woman yelling George's name continually. All looked sad, until a woman's voice clearly yelled "Eddie, we love you". When George entered the studio, the crowd went crazy, and Teresa and her sister were waiting to greet him. Lots of tears and laughter flowed.

- Julie asked George how he feels, and he responded that it is wonderful to be out of the house. He said the house guests were fantastic to him and he's glad he made it this far. He said that it took about 2-3 weeks in the beginning for him and the others to adapt to each other, but then he felt that he became young again, and acted like he was 20. When shown clips of his various adventures in the house, including his many costumes, the letter from his family, hair color and the planned walkout, he laughed and cried. He said he enjoyed himself in the house, and when asked what his favorite moment was, he said there were too many to choose one. Julie asked him about the walkout plan, and he explained that the messages from the sky led him to believe that they would all win money if they all left together. He said they thought CBS was behind the plane banners, and since there is barely any information inside the house, they had to take what they had and work with it. Julie asked him about the apparent "plan" he and Teresa spoke about during their first phone conversation, and George explained that the "plan" was to mow the lawn and take care of the house, not some big scheme they had cooked up to win the money. George said that every day in the Red Room he was asked about the "plan", but that was all it was.
- Julie then reminded George of the anti-George banners and his statement the other day about possibly being the most hated man in America. She assured him he is not the most hated man, and then showed him video footage of the party George's friends and family threw for Teresa and the girls, the rally in Texas and the key to a small town given to George, and George-day with cheerleaders and tons of fans. George looked like he was going to bust out of his seat. Julie then asked George who he would like to see win, and he said Eddie, and will vote for him. He said that he did not take the nominations personally and knew that Eddie was going to play the game strategically. George then said a final live goodbye to the house guests, telling them that they won't believe what has happened out there and that they each have a special place in his heart. When asked what's next for George, he responded something decent to eat, and he doesn't believe he has a career in acting waiting for him. Julie then told George and his family that the Southern Vermont College heard his concerns about his daughters college education, and have offered a 4 year scholarship for any one of George's daughters. While George cried at this wonderful news, Julie cracked a joke by telling him he now has 10 seconds to choose which daughter. The show ended with Julie announcing that the live show on Saturday will include the final nominations.

Day 79 (Thursday, September 21, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 78 and the house guests in the backyard. A plane flew overhead that read "Go Eddie - jireh.com supports nwba.org". Eddie told the others that nwba means the National Wheelchair Basketball Association, and he thanked whoever for the message and said he appreciates it. Jamie then told Josh about an earlier banner that read "Vote Jamie out - Look out Josh 2 faced lying fraud". They didn't know if it meant Josh is two faced or Jamie. Jamie said that it doesn't matter who you nominate, they are all friends, and it could always be interpreted as two faced. Later, the house guests worked on the Headline News challenge answering a question that read "Rosie O'Donnell big Eddie fan" as true (it is true). Another question that read "Brit returns to Hollywood for film audition" was also answered true (it is true).
- Eddie explained the reason behind pinning an aids ribbon to his mask. His mother's younger brother, Eddie's uncle, died of aids in his mid-30s. He told Josh and Curtis that his mother got to him just before he died, and that Eddie used to be close to him when he was younger, but his uncle moved to Maine and he didn't see him much after that. Eddie told Josh and Curtis about how BB woke him up that morning. Suddenly, BB's voice boomed over the speaker that it's 1:00 a.m. and it's time for bed. Next, the sexy BB voice came over the loudspeaker translating the first message into Spanish. The boys thought this was hilarious and laughed really loud. Jamie came out to find out what she missed, and they told her while Curtis hugged her.
- Day 79 - The group sat at the dining room table, and Eddie said he had the sudden urge to knock Jamie off her chair. He said he would find more pleasure in that than in giving hugs. Jamie looked quite uncomfortable and suddenly got up and left. Later, Jamie

joined Eddie in the boys bedroom, where Eddie lay in bed, and gave him her latest poem. She wished him luck with the banishment process that night and told him that she likes him and he has a good heart. She said she's really enjoyed her time in the house, and Eddie responded by saying he can think of many other ways to spend a summer but it's been okay. Jamie awkwardly hugged him and left the room. That evening after George's banishment, the group talked about George, and Jamie announced that she believed she was going to be the one who got banished. She did all the infomercials with George, and thought maybe she would be targeted by Illinois. Curtis said he hopes he doesn't get nominated again, and then asked for a little teamwork from the group. They all laughed at that one. Eddie congratulated them all for making it this far. Only one more has to go, then there will be only two days left in the house as three. Curtis said he believes BB will do lots of weird stuff to them this last week.

- The group worked on the Headline News stories again, and the show ended with the four playing in the pool.

Day 80 (Friday, September 22, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with the weekly "Headline News" challenge. The house guests were each given a number of questions randomly chosen from the 100 plus headlines they had been reading all week. They could only get six headlines wrong between the four of them. In the beginning, they were getting a lot wrong, and they seemed distracted by the real answers to the headlines. For example, when they answered false to the Headline News "Naked pictures of BB house guests are on the Internet" and were told that was actually true, they couldn't believe it. They were very happy to hear that Rosie O'Donnell is a big fan of Eddie, and that Brit has been signed by a major Hollywood talent agency. They ended up being successful on the challenge and won 50% of their grocery money (drinking resumes this week I guess). As a bonus, each house guest was given the opportunity to find out the answer to one of the Headline News questions not asked in the challenge. Eddie asked if it was true or false if the Wheelchair Basketball Association had started a fund in his name. BB advised him it was true. Josh asked if it was true/false if the naked shower cam was broadcasted into the Emmy's. BB answered this was false. Curtis asked if Karen had a cooking show. BB answered this was false. Jamie asked if it was true/false if there is a Wizard of Oz film on the Internet with them in it. BB answered it is true.
- Josh told the house guests he is concerned with Cassandra coming back to the house, and he doesn't want to know anything. He then went into the Red Room and told BB that he feels any outside news will distract him and he wants to enjoy the last week in the house. He told the house guests that he would be interested in news about them but not himself. Curtis then went to the Red Room to tell BB he at first thought Josh was crazy not to want to know what Cassandra has to tell them, but now realizes he wants to keep an element of surprise when he leaves. Curtis said he believes there is nothing out there negative about Josh. Jamie then went to the Red Room to find a BB board game. At first she didn't believe it was real, and ran excitedly out to the others to show them the game. They all played it and had a good laugh.
- Eddie in the Red Room told BB that he thinks Cass coming back to the house is wonderful and will prepare them for their departure. He thinks Cass will have watched all the past tapes and will be able to tell them everything they need to know. The house guests were given their next challenge. A "Mole"-like challenge that makes one of them the Saboteur and the others Secret Agents. The Saboteur will be given tasks to sabotage something in the house, and the Agents will have to figure out who the Saboteur is. They can not talk to each other about what their respective roles are and the winner of the challenge will get to keep the BB TV after they leave the house. Each took turns going into the Red Room and choosing a card. Eddie, Curtis and Jamie were all tasked as Secret Agents, Josh was chosen as the Saboteur. His task was to set the potatoe clock back 1/2 hour each day. Later, Josh and Curtis discussed the public's opinion of them, and Curtis said he believes the public knows them better than they know each other. He said he can't imagine that one of them is different than they appear and that they have really gotten to know each other these past three months.

He said he believes if someone is fake, the public would have voted them out of the house by now.

- Josh went to the Red Room and told BB that this has become more than a game now. The money can easily change someone's life, and they will get a full spiel from him at nominations time but not yet. That evening, Josh was shown sneaking around trying to get to the potatoe clock and set it back 1/2 hour without getting caught by the Secret Agents. He did it successfully.

Day 81 (Saturday, September 23, 2000) CBS Last Live Nomination Show

- Julie Chen opened the live show by advising the viewers that Cassandra will be returning to the house tonight, and is actually waiting in the Red Room. She then went live to the house guests who were completely caught off guard. Josh and Curtis were in the backyard, Jamie was in the washroom and Eddie was asleep in bed. Their time was off because of the sabotage to the potato clock. Julie asked them to assemble in the living room, and Jamie scrambled to brush her hair, put on her lipgloss and attach her microphone. Eddie sleepily went to the living room, his pants falling down in the process. Julie asked them how they were feeling, and how it would be to be in the fourth spot. They all agreed the fourth spot is the worst spot, however, Jamie said you will miss out on two days in the house, and some money. Josh said it will still have been a good experience.
- Julie then told them that there is a surprise waiting for them and asked them to open the Red Room door. They did and out walked Cassandra, giving them each a bag of goodies. Everyone was really excited as they greeted Cassandra. She told them right away that she has not watched the tapes of the show, nor watched the show since she was banished, however, will tell them about her experience and what they can expect when they leave the house. She said there are five things she wants to tell them, and began with the Big Brother website being very popular and rated #1 amongst all websites. She then said the ratings for the show are good, and CBS ratings are up 138% since last summer for age groups 15-34, and up 24% overall for the time-slot the show is on TV. She then told them that people will recognize them on the street and she almost missed her flight to LA from NY because of fans. She said that people like them and can relate to them. Next she said that she has spoken to all of their families and they are all doing well and looking forward to having them return home. Finally she said that there are all kinds of opportunities out in the world for them and that they will have to move quickly when they leave, and the opportunities will depend on the person and what they are looking for.
- Julie interrupted the conversation by reminding the house guests that business must be taken care of and it is time for the first of the four to go to the Red Room to cast their live nominations for banishment. They each took turns during the duration of the show and the nominations went like this:
 - Eddie - voted for Curtis & Jamie
 - Josh - voted for Curtis & Jamie
 - Curtis - voted for Eddie & Josh
 - Jamie - voted for Eddie & Josh
 - Total was 2 votes each meaning they are all up for banishment on Wednesday night.
- Julie then updated the viewers on Jordan's status, reporting that she now has a one day a week radio DJ job at The Point radio station in Minneapolis. Jordan was shown at the station listening to the house guests lyrics to the BB theme song, and telling her hosts to turn it off. She said she feels that she has been judged badly by the public, and it has been a painful experience. She was filmed cleaning out her locker at the stripclub she worked at, and said she is working on finishing her book. Julie then interviewed Dr. Drew Pinsky who said Cassandra will manage the house guests questions well and is very responsible in what she is telling them. They then discussed the lack of romance in the BB house, and Dr. Drew explained that Jamie is very contained, strong and concerned about how she is perceived. He also said that the fourth spot will be very disappointing for any of the house guests, but they all seem to have a very good attitude about the experience as a whole.

- Josh's family and friends were shown holding another party for him in his hometown. Julie then interviewed Regina Lewis, AOL spokesperson, who said that messages are being posted online at one message per second. There are lots of discussion about the fourth place, and the fact that only three guys and one girl are left in the house. A survey conducted that asked who would receive the most nominations for banishment resulted in Jamie 66%, Eddie 22%, Curtis 9%, Josh 3%. People on the street were then asked what their most memorable BB moments were, and all kinds were mentioned including the mudwrestling in the backyard, George impersonating Karen in the Red Room and Curtis finding the ticket to win the trip to the Emmy Awards. We then went back to the house guests and Cassandra's discussion. Cass told them about the media tours and what to expect when leaving the house. She said she will be flying back home tomorrow and that she flies first class now. She also warned them that the attention could fade anytime, and to just go with the flow.
- {E}ddie's family and friends were shown holding a party for Eddie at Fuzzys Bar in NY. The Southern Vermont College was also shown with reference to the four year scholarship they gave to George's daughter, Jessica. The house guests told Cass about the BB boardgame, and about the many planes that are still flying overhead with the various messages to them. Cass told them she has no regrets regarding her time in the house and she is really happy she did it. She said they should expect to run on adrenaline when they leave the house, but will have time to reflect about the time they spent in the house and what they learned there. Julie then told Cass it was time for her to leave and she said her goodbyes to the house guests. She then joined Julie in the studio and said that the house guests seem more subdued, Chiquita is thinner and the boys need haircuts.
- {J}ulie then notified the house guests of the results of the nominations, identifying each with two votes leaving them all up for banishment. Eddie said that was cool and it is up to the public. Curtis agreed that it is nicer this way. They then talked about dinner, and Karen and Brit hanging out with Josh's sister. There was a long moment of silence, and Jamie had a concerned look on her face. To vote for who you would like to be banished from the house on Wednesday night, call 1(900)740-1000 (U.S.) and 1(900)870-9846 (Canada).

Day 83 (Monday, September 25, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opened with the house guests sitting around the dining room table, and Eddie telling them the story of when he was younger and found out he had cancer. It was very touching. He then went to the Red Room where he told BB that people don't appreciate what they have until it's gone. When he lost his leg, he realized how much it meant to have two legs, and he gets mad when people waste their life away when they have both their legs. He also said that it would bother him when his younger brother would sit around playing video games all day, when he could have been outside running around, or skateboarding.
- The house guests were outside in the backyard when a plane flew overhead with a message that read "Boys - Jamie 2 faced in the RR - saveeddie.com" Jamie was upset by this message and said that it makes her mad because she said nice things about Eddie when she was in the Red Room. Eddie questioned why he would need a Website called saveeddie.com. Curtis and Jamie went inside, and Eddie thanked the website, then said that it is getting weird. Curtis hugged Jamie in the kitchen and told her that no one thinks that of her. Jamie said she is sensitive to those types of messages, and Eddie told them it's getting weirder all the time. Josh and Eddie then went outside to lift weights.
- Josh, in the Red Room, told BB that being the saboteur, and trying to mess with the house guests clock, is very funny for him, and he tries not to laugh whenever someone comments about the time. He said he even changed the time right in front of them one day, but thinks Curtis may be on to him now. He said he doesn't care about winning the TV, and that Eddie and Curtis really want it. Another plane flew by later that day, that read "Hi all - chikanman lives - AB.C" The house guests thought that the message could have been from George, and Jamie pointed out that he spelled the message wrong.

Curtis joked that it could definitely be George, and imitated George telling the pilot to slow down so he could get a better view. Eddie thought that was hilarious.

- Day 82 - Eddie, bored I think, started rapping and making up funny lyrics in the kitchen. He was wearing a BB cap, and kept turning it around, pretending to be a rapper. Later, Curtis and Josh spoke privately while lying on the couches in the living room. Curtis asked Josh if he would date Brittany after the show. Josh responded that the feelings are still there, and he liked her very much. He questioned whether his feelings were due to being locked in the house together, but missed her when she left and when he saw her on the video on the TV. She gave him confidence when she asked to speak to him on the phone, and he will see how he feels when he leaves the house. He said that when they were doing the dance challenge, he danced 25 hours with Brittany and never once got bored. Curtis said that Brit was so funny and he loved her. He then asked Josh if he was hitting on Jordan. Josh responded that he was just flirting with Jordan, and was physically attracted to her, but really cared for Brit. He then said that he will request that Brit be outside the house when he leaves.
- Later that same evening, Josh and Curtis were still awake, however Josh was falling asleep on the couch. It was time for him to set the potato clock back 1/2 hour, only Curtis wouldn't go to bed. At 12:52 they both went to the boys room, but shortly thereafter, Josh got up, probably to change the clock. He ate some cake while sitting at the dining room table, and suddenly Curtis got up and went to the kitchen (it looked like he was checking on Josh). When he left, Josh set the clock back to 12:52 (it read 1:22). He then went to bed. The next morning (Day 83), Curtis woke up early and checked the clock. It still read 12:52, because Josh had inadvertently left it in program mode. Curtis went in the Red Room and told BB that he believes Josh is the saboteur and the sabotage is to the clock. BB thanked him but did not tell him if he was right or wrong.
- The show ended with clips of Josh trying to change the clock and not get caught by the house guests. CBS announced tonight that the BB finale will be aired on Friday night (Sept.29).

Day 84 (Tuesday, September 26, 2000) CBS Show

- The show opened with Day 83 and the house guests sitting around the dining room table talking about how far they've come. Eddie said he believed he would be banished from the house the first week because he is very outspoken. Josh thought the older house guests would make it the furthest. Jamie said she had no idea what would happen in the first two weeks. The three guys later discussed the nomination process, and Curtis stated that he has been nominated for banishment five out of seven rounds. Eddie admitted to nominating him four of the five times, and Curtis responded "thanks dude". All were laughing. This lead into a discussion about who nominated who during each particular session. Jamie joined the boys, and with much laughter, they each identified the house guests they had nominated for each particular session and gave their reasons why. By the time it got to the last nominations, all were laughing, and no one seemed to take it personally.
- Eddie told Curtis that while in the Red Room, BB asked him who he thinks will get banished this week. Eddie responded that he thinks it will be Jamie or himself. He said he thinks it might be Jamie because she has received the most negative messages from the sky, and if people are going to pay \$300.00 to fly a message, they'll pay a lot to make repeated phone calls. Curtis said BB asked him about voting strategically, but Curtis said he had no idea how the others were voting, so he couldn't vote strategically. Eddie responded that everyone should leave the house looking out for themselves, and that he is there to have fun and win the money.
- Day 84 - All the house guests were told to watch the TV provided by BB, regarding the Saboteur challenge. The time shown on the TV was 10:30 a.m. Monday, and Eddie appeared in the Red Room. He told BB that he hasn't been concentrating on the challenge and accused BB of being the Saboteur. Next, Jamie told BB she has no clue who the Saboteur is but said if she has to hazard a guess, she would choose Eddie because he moves the chair so that two legs are always off the floor. This got a loud laugh from the boys. Clips were then shown of Josh, sneaking around, while the others

were in bed, changing the time on the potato clock. Curtis was then shown telling BB he believes the Saboteur is Josh and the sabotage is messing with the time on the clock. Curtis then explained to everyone how he came to that conclusion, stating that the camera was always on the potato clock, and Josh always took so much time coming to bed each night. All laughed, and Curtis won the TV trinitron.

- {T}he show ended with all the house guests in the boys room, and Eddie starting some kind of funny dance singing a "trinitron" song. All the others joined in, and Curtis started doing a "trinitron" dance which was absolutely hilarious!

Day 85 (Wednesday, September 27, 2000) CBS Last Live Banishment Show

- Julie Chen opened the live show, asking the house guests if they are all packed, and ready to possibly move out tonight. She told them that all the votes are in and counted, however, there's been a change in plans. She explained that there will be two banishments tonight, and that a tribute to the first banished guest will be shown on the TV. All watched to see clips of Chiquita, first arriving at the house and her escapades while there. The house guests watched, and laughed at the video. Julie told them that Chiquita will be adopted by a new family tonight, and they now have two minutes to say goodbye to her. The four ran to the yard and Josh picked up Chiquita. They each said goodbye to her, told her they love her, and told her not to poop on anyone. Josh placed her outside the house door, and Chiquita was coaxed through the main BB house pet door to the outside world. She popped out to see her new family, a BB staff and his wife, waiting to take her home. She didn't want to leave and kept going back to the front door, where she sat and waited. Her new owners picked her up and carried her down the path to the awaiting fans.
- Julie then gave us an update about George, showing George and Teresa in New York city, meeting fans and being photographed by People Magazine. George, with his dyed blonde hair, talked with fans in person and on cell phones, and told us that he doesn't understand why people are so interested in him, and that he is just a normal person. Julie then interviewed Dr. Drew Pinsky who talked about the key turning points in the BB experience. The key ones for him were Jordan being banished from the house, and the house guests discussing it after; and George's rebellion when he had the house guests convinced to do a group walk-out. Dr. Drew said that Curtis attending the Emmy Awards brought some reality back into the house, and made them realize it is just a game. He said that the BB experience has been very powerful and fascinating for him, and that the courageous participants have really taught us all about community and integrity. They have always chosen peace and set a good example.
- Julie then gave an update on Brittany, showing her attending her first audition, where she read for a part with the show's producer. After, she said she "sucked", but the producer told us that he thought she was quite good. Julie then interviewed Regina Lewis, the AOL spokesperson, who said that there is a different feel on the Internet these days, and that people are routing for who should win the grand prize. A recent poll asking who has the best strategy resulted in Eddie with 53%, Josh 24%, Curtis 15% and Jamie 8%. Julie then showed clips of the highlights of the past three months, including Eddie's lecture to the house guests about discussion nominations, George's phone conversation with Teresa, Jamie picking the casting director over her mother, the group turning down the \$50,000 to leave early, Brit's call to Josh, and the last six house guests being banished from the house.
- Julie then went live to the house guests to inform them which one is banished from the house tonight. She told Eddie, Curtis and Josh that they are all staying and Jamie has to leave. She was not given a percentage of how many votes she received (estimated to be in the 70% range). Jamie hugged the three boys, and left the house quite quickly. She was greeted at the end of the path by her mother and her friend. She then hugged as many people as she could in the crowd that had gathered to greet her. The boys went to their regular spot in the backyard and heard people yelling their names over the wall, telling them to hang in there. They yelled back to their fans. Suddenly Eddie yelled to Curtis and Josh, "we f***ing won dudes!". They all seemed quite happy and excited. Josh ran in the house to pee, while Curtis and Eddie continued to converse with adoring fans on the other side of the wall. Jamie joined Julie in the studio, where

again, she hugged everyone she saw, and jumped up and down clapping her hands together.

- Julie asked Jamie how she felt, and Jamie responded that she has felt intense all day, has not eaten anything, and has had a feeling in her stomach that she would be the one to banish since yesterday. She said she didn't want to go but is happy for the boys. She said that fourth place sucks, but believes when God closes a door, he opens a window. When asked about the accent the house guests use so frequently, Jamie explained that when they were given the Tour de France challenge, they were told to speak in French accents. Julie said she didn't know the accents were supposed to be French. Julie then showed Jamie clips of the past 86 days in the house. After, Jamie explained that while in the house, you go through every emotion you can imagine. She said the last two weeks has been just her and the guys, and she has learned a lot. When Julie asked her why there were no romantic sparks in the house, Jamie explained that getting into a relationship in the house would have got in the way of the whole experience, but that a relationship could develop outside of the house. Julie then asked her about her concerns of how she was portrayed to the world, showing clips of Jamie talking to Curtis about "storylines" and being careful about what she said. Jamie explained that as Miss Washington, she felt that she is a role model for others, and that she didn't defend herself against the negative banner messages because you have to suck it up and deal with it.
- Jamie then said her live goodbye to the boys, telling them the next two days will be wild and she congratulated them all. Julie asked Jamie who she believes will win the grand prize. Jamie answered that she hopes Eddie will win it, but is the closest to Curtis and Josh. During a commercial break, we were told to go to CBS.com to participate in future BB shows, or give comments about the past one. Julie then told the three boys that they have one more challenge to complete tonight. She asked Curtis to go to the Red Room, and once there, Curtis was given 30 seconds to say who he hopes to win the grand prize and why. Curtis responded that he hopes he wins the money but would be very glad to see the other two win it also. Next, Eddie responded that he hopes Josh wins the money because he's a good kid, and has his niece to put through school. Finally, Josh said that he hopes Eddie will win, because his family needs it the most, and that it's not just about them in the house but also extends to their families. After, the three discussed them leaving the Red Room, and Eddie told them that when Julie told him he could leave the room, he winked, and could hear the audience laughing. Josh said that when he was done, and Julie told him to leave the room, he said "alright babe". They all got quite a laugh out of that.-
- The show ended giving us instructions on how to vote for the winner. Call 1(900)740-1000 (U.S.) and 1(900)870-9846 (Canada) and vote for the house guest you WANT to win. The finale of BB will be held this Friday, Sept.29.

Day 86 (Thursday, September 28, 2000) CBS Show

- The show began with Day 85 and the four house guests discussing their favourite BB moments. Clips were then shown of George falling over the bucket while playing ball; the group of 8 playing water basketball in the pool, and getting bruises and scratches all over themselves; George fighting with the hose; Ed slipping in the bathroom while Josh was in the shower; George's spaceship infomercial; Cass peeling the eggplant; Josh and Curtis making the cucumber and corn talk to each other; and the first night of drinking when Karen and Brit were standing on the dining room table and Ed was sitting on a chair on the table.
- Day 86 - after Jamie was banished, the boys were sequestered to the bedroom where they were asked who they thought would be the final three left in the BB house. Josh said he thought Karen, George and Eddie would be last because Karen & George represented the mom & dad, and Eddie was outspoken. Curt thought it would be Josh, Jordan and Karen or George because they were the all American family. Eddie thought it would be Karen, George & Brit because Karen & George appealed to the older audience, and Brit appealed to younger viewers. They were then asked about the lack of romance during the past three months, and why they think nothing happened. Eddie responded that he loves Monica, however, he was attracted to Jamie in the beginning,

never to Jordan, and thought of Brit as a sister. Curtis said he knew it was crazy to have a relationship in the house. He said he was attracted to Brit because of her personality. Josh thought something would happen with him in the house. He said he was attracted to Jordan but knew they would never agree on anything. He also thought Jamie was pretty, but they had too much in common and have totally different personalities. Finally, he said he was attracted to Brit because she was so funny, and he almost kissed her, but questioned his feelings for her because they were stuck in the house. He said their time was cut short in the house.

- Later that night, after some pretty heavy-duty drinking, BB played the German BB theme song, and Josh got up and started dancing. He took off his jeans and danced in his underwear and socks. He swept the kitchen floor, moonwalked, then pulled down his underwear and mooned the boys. Eddie and Curtis yelled in disgust and Eddie called him a sick f***. Josh continued to dance, then put a sponge down the front of his underwear and pulled it out the bottom. They were laughing so hard they could hardly speak (I must admit I had tears streaming down my face it was SO funny!). After the dance, Curt told him that was the grossest thing he had ever seen and to put his pants back on. When Josh joined them, Curtis said he would certainly get the gay vote now. Next Curtis dyed Josh's hair blue, using no gloves I must add. Eddie kept repeating that he had nothing to do with it. Curtis told Josh he will be more attractive to Brit now. Josh then ran around the house putting blue handprints on all the walls while Eddie called him a pixie.
- The show ended with the boys dancing around, and instructions on how to vote for the winner. The finale of Big Brother will be Friday evening, and the grand prize winner will be announced then.

Day 87 (Friday, September 29, 2000) CBS Series Finale Show

- The live finale of BB began with Julie advising us she does not know who the grand winner will be. She went live to Eddie, Josh & Curtis and asked them how they were feeling. Curtis said he is excited to see his family and friends, and was again wearing his banishment outfit. Josh said he was nervous, and Eddie said he was feeling fine. Julie then asked them each to repeat out loud who they wanted to win from their discussion in the Red Room the other night. They each took their turn with Curtis saying he said himself, and Eddie and Josh saying each other.
- Julie then brought in the past seven house guests to the studio and asked them who they believed would win the grand prize. All of them said Eddie except Jamie who said Josh, and Cassandra who said Curtis. Julie then asked each of the banished house guests how they were feeling outside of the house and whether the BB experience had changed them. Karen said she didn't want to stay in the house, and left when the fun was over. She said she could never have made it until the very end. Brit explained her phone call with Josh, saying that she didn't say what she wanted to say in the proper way, and likes everyone in the house, except Mega (with a laugh). Jordan said she felt the house was lacking heart to heart discussions, because it was all about entertainment and people were too worried about how they were being portrayed. Cass said she still has not watched any episodes and wants to remain true to the experience. The others teased her about being a diplomat. George, dressed in a chicken costume, said that Cass taught him the most in the house, since she carried herself so well, and he admired her so much. Jamie said she's had two hours sleep in 48 hours and has read hundreds of e-mails.

She then showed both Eddie and Josh clips of their time in the house and asked Eddie about the experience. Eddie said it was a wild ride, with lots of ups and downs, but overall he enjoyed the time in the house. He said he made friends there and that interfered with his strategy. He became closer to the people than he intended and really cares for them now. He will miss the house and has made friends for life. Josh's clips were kind of depressing and focussed a lot on his early days of flirting with the three girls. He said the house was like a vacation for him, and it was easier in the house than in real life; an escape. He said the house changed him for the better, and he feels he understands people better now. The two were then asked to give a final message to each other. Eddie wished Josh luck and thanked him; Josh said to Eddie that he's one of the best friends he's ever had.
